Approximate finished length: 3.50 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

4 beads - Size 11 Starlight Permanent Galvanized Round Japanese Seed Beads By Toho - PF557 (SB5934)
4 beads - 3.5mm White Potato Freshwater Pearl (PL0555)
2 beads - 7mm White Potato Freshwater Pearl (PL0560)
1 - 16mm Gold-Filled Plain Leverback Earring (GF2780)
24 inches - Base Metal 1.5mm Twisted Helix Beading Chain (CN3118)
8 inches - Round Gold-Filled Half Hard Wire - 24 gauge - 5 feet (GW0116)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

Chain nose pliers
Round nose pliers
Wire cutters

Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:

Wire Wrapped Link
Cutting Chain Efficiently

Instructions to complete “Pearl Bliss” earrings:

Step 1

Cut the chain into the following lengths (see Cutting Chain Efficiently Technique):

12 – 2 inch lengths

Set aside six lengths of chain for the second earring.

Step 2

Using a 4-inch length of wire, make a wire wrapped link (see Wire Wrapped Link Technique) with the following beads –

1 – 3.5mm pearl

1 – seed bead

1 – 7mm pearl

1 – seed bead

1 – 3.5mm pearl

Attach one side of this wire wrapped link to the loop on one ear wire, and attach the other side to one end link of the six lengths of chain.

Step 3

Repeat Step 2 for the second earring.
