## **INWARD IN DISCIPLESHIP**

The process of spiritual growth happens personally (as an individual) and corporately (in a community).

Now that you have become a new creation in Christ, you can begin growing into a mature follower of Jesus.

EPHESIANS 4:14-15


"So in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others."

# PUBLICLY DECLARE YOUR FAITH THROUGH BAPTISM

"Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." ACTS 2:38

## STUDY THE WORD OF GOD

God wants an intimate, personal relationship with you. That relationship is strengthened through studying the Bible—God's revelation to you.

## **PRAY**

The acrostic ACTS can help you to begin developing your prayer life. When you pray use the following pattern for prayer:



### **ADORATION**

Give adoration and praise to God, focusing on who God is. (Psalm 145:1-3)



### CONFESSION

Confess and acknowledge your sins before God in order to receive forgiveness. (1 John 1:9)



### **THANKSGIVING**

Give thanks and express gratitude to God for His goodness to you. (1 Thessalonians 5:18)



### SUPPLICATION

Supplication is making requests, expressing desires to God, and praying for the needs of others. (Philippians 4:6-7)



## **SHARE JESUS WITH OTHERS**

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." ACTS 1:8

"Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." JOHN 15:4-5

ACTS 2:42-47




# **BE IN A CONNECT GROUP**

#### **BUILDING MEANINGFUL RELATIONSHIPS**

Connect Groups give you the opportunity to be with a smaller group of people with whom you can build trusting relationships.

### PRAYING AND CARING

You will discover that people in our Connect Groups genuinely care about one another and pray for each other. This is one of the sweet blessings of being an active member in a Connect Group— you are not alone in life and are surrounded by a group who loves and cares for you.

### **REACHING AND SERVING**

Reaching and Serving is one of our core values, but it is also one of the blessings of being an active member in a Connect Group. Each Connect Group is always involved in reaching those who need Jesus and serving the needs of others.

### **SHARING YOUR STORY**

If you have already trusted Jesus as your Lord and Savior, please share your salvation experience and your baptism experience with a leader. If this is your first time to hear the gospel, or if you have heard it before and you still have questions, they will be available to help answer your questions. Our leadership partners will not pressure you to take this step of faith. It is a personal decision that each individual must make. We want to be sure that when you trust Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, that it is something that you want with all of your heart.
