

If you are an RN or LPN/LVN in a state with continuing education (CE) requirements for licensure renewal, this job aid will guide you in finding courses that award CE and how to determine if the CE applies to your state.

Basic Information

CE contact hours for nurses are assigned through a national board – American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) – and/or individual state boards. ANCC CE is accepted in all 50 states. The California and Florida Boards of Nursing prefer courses that have CE assigned through their state bodies. Both options are available in Relias.


Over 200 courses that offer CE for nurses in the Relias system, assigned by either Kindred or Relias.



- Filter the "All License" drop down menu to "ANCC (KAH) American Nurses Credentialing Center" for the Kindred courses approved for credit.
- Filter the "All License" drop down menu to "ANCC (Gentiva) American Nurses Credentialing Center" for the legacy Gentiva courses approved for credit.
- Filter the "All License" drop down menu to "ANCC American Nurses Credentialing Center" for the Relias-owned courses approved for credit.

Directions for RN and LPN/LVN Continuing Education (CE) Course Search in KAHL

- A course evaluation is part of the completion requirements and must be submitted before the course will move to your Completed Training.
- To print certificates, please click on the certificate icon under the course title on your Completed Training. When prompted, select the board from which you want a certificate. Be sure to have license information added to KAH Learning.

Additional Information

- Some states do not require continuing education hours at this time for RNs and LPNs/LVNs.
- It is the responsibility of the individual license holder to understand state specific requirements. Some states mandate course content like infection control or Alzheimer's disease.
- It is the intent of the Kindred at Home Learning and Development Team to provide clinicians with opportunities for CE growth. Continuing education across the spectrum is a complicated process that is rapidly evolving and changing with much state-to-state variability and specificity.
- All requirements of a given state may not be available in the learning management system.
- We encourage you to access your state board website often for detailed information about expectations.
