Removes rings if required by location; also removes watch and bracelets or wears them well above the wrist.					, and
With arms angled downward under the faucet, adjusts the water temperature until it is comfortably warm.					
Wets hands and wrists with warm water, and apply soap from a dispenser. Keeps below elbow level. Works up a generous lather by rubbing hands					
together vigorously for at least 20 seconds. Pays special attention to the areas under fingernails and around cuticles as well as to thumbs, knuckles, and sides of fingers and hands. If rings not removed, moves them up and down fingers to clean beneath them.					
Avoids splashing water on self and the floor.					
Avoids touching the sink and faucet.					
Rinses hands and wrists well.					
Pats hands and wrists dry with a paper towel.					
If the sink is not equipped with knee or foot controls, turns off the faucets by gripping them with a dry paper towel.
