PART 1

Scripture Reflection

As a staff, take a few moments to sit in total silence. Silence is a rare commodity and central to how God speaks with us.

Slowly read aloud this passage from Philippians 2

Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, 2 then make my joy complete by being likeminded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. 3 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, 4 not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

Now, take a few moments in silence and read it one more time and then discuss the following questions in a small group

Questions For Group Discussion:

While some subjectivity is part of simply being human it becomes a problem when it becomes an essential filter for life? How does subjectivity manifest itself in the students you work with? Do you see any problems with it?

How can your school community address undue subjectivity or selfishness? What practical things are being done or could be tried to help students engage with a more outward-focussed approach to others and life itself?

Take a moment to read aloud the issues listed from the document The Catholic School On The Threshold of The Third Millennium.
