Scripture Reading

STEP ONE

As a staff, take a few moments to sit in total silence. Silence is a rare commodity and central to how God speaks with us.

STEP TWO

After some time in silence, have one person read the following scripture aloud:

A READING FROM THE BOOK OF ROMANS CHAPTER 10 v 14 - 15

How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? 15 And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

Now, take a few moments in silence and the read it one more time.

As a staff what do you think about the general perception of how open young people are to the Gospel? What factors make it challenging at this time in history to teach the faith?

QUESTION TWO

How much confidence do you have as a staff in communicating the message of faith in compelling ways? Is there a sense of missionary enthusiasm or is it seen as too hard?
