QUESTION ONE

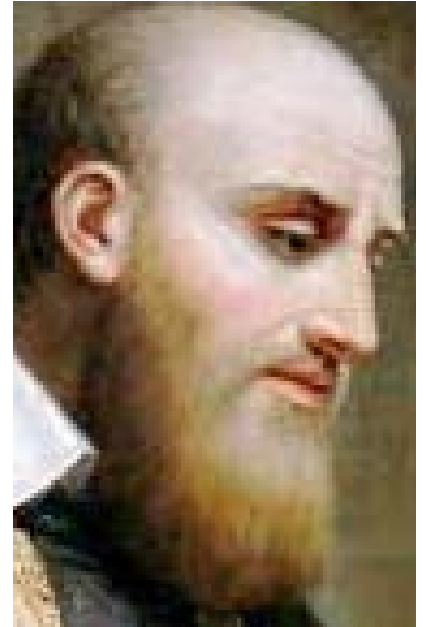
