Going Deeper

Scripture Reflection

Scripture makes it very clear that God wants to give us good things. He wants to actually give each of us the Holy Spirit to deepen our sense of vocation.

STEP ONE

As a staff, take a few moments to sit in total silence. Silence is a rare commodity and central to how God speaks with us.

STEP TWO

After some time in silence, have one person read the following scripture aloud:

A Reading from the Book of Kings Chapter 19 v.11

"The Lord said, "Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the Lord, for the Lord is about to pass by."

Then a great and powerful wind tore the mountains apart and shattered the rocks before the Lord, but the Lord was not in the wind. After the wind there was an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake. After the earthquake came a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire. And after the fire came a gentle whisper. When Elijah heard it, he pulled his cloak over his face and went out and stood at the mouth of the cave."

Now, take a few moments in silence and the read it one more time.

QUESTION ONE

We often assume that the spiritual or 'supernatural' action of God will be spectacular. As such, what message do you think this scripture is trying to communicate?

QUESTION TWO

In your opinion what role does silence play in the life of your shool at the moment? What practical ways could this be addressed?

Closing Prayer


Lord we thank you for the gift of silence
