### ***Discussion Questions***

- What does Moses learn about God in this passage?
- What does Moses learn about himself? What is he struggling with?
- What does it mean to be commissioned by God?

#### ***Racial Barriers***

- What racial barriers existed in Egypt?
- What racial barriers have you encountered?
- What did Dr. John Perkins mean by stating, "Take the gospel to every ethnic group, not take the gospel to every race?"
- How does the gospel break through racial barriers?
- What is the difference between the Law and the Promise? (Gal. 3:15-22)
