Discussion Questions

COMFORT ZONES

- Why did rivers (water) play an important role in the ancient world?
- What did Ur of the Chaldeans provide for Abram?
- What route did Abram take after hearing God tell him to leave Harran?
- What was the problem with the *promise land*?
- Do you think that total dependence on God is easy or hard? Why?
- What areas do you get stuck in? What comfort zone is hard for you to come out of?

HYPOCRITES

- Why does our faith demand a response?
- Why is the bible a holistic type of faith?
- How do we avoid hypocrisy?

READ Luke 17:11-19

- How did Jesus handle this situation?
- What did the one leper do that the other nine did not?

ALTARS

- Why did Abram build the first altar?
- What is the purpose of altars? Did all the altars require animal sacrifices or were there other reasons for building them?

Lordship

- What does it mean to have a *functional* lord? Why does this need to be dethroned?
- What can you learn from Abram's obedience?
