Serve Day Project Leader FAQ

What is the role of a SERVE Day project leader?

Your role as a project leader is to coordinate the details of your SERVE project. 1) Recruit a team to serve with (your small group, weekend service team members, friends or family). 2) Identify the individual, family or organization you'd like to serve and their needs. 3) Communicate times (start and end), supplies needed and HAVE FUN!

How do I plan a SERVE Day project?

Get creative! Assess people and their needs in your neighborhood and around your community. This year we'd like to focus on our first responders and healthcare workers who've been on the frontlines of the COVID-19 pandemic. Firefighters, police officers, school resource officers, nursing home residents, assisted living homes and local business owners are all great people to reach out to and find a way to SERVE! And, projects are certainly not limited to just those groups. Perhaps there's a widow, single mother or elderly person who could use assistance with painting their house, yardwork or other cleaning. How do I let the church know which SERVE Day project I'm planning?

Who pays the costs associated with SERVE projects (supplies, travel expenses, etc.)?

What should I bring on SERVE Day?

Plan on bringing any personal items you may need, like your SERVE Day t-shirt, sunscreen, drinking water, tennis shoes, a hat, etc., along with any items pertaining to your service project such as rakes, gloves, lawnmowers, tarps, work tools, etc. For projects requiring physical labor, work clothes are a good idea. We recommend not wearing jewelry.

What if it rains?

If you have an outdoor project, make plans to have an inclement weather option in mind. This may include moving your project to the following Saturday or joining an indoor serve project.
