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WG1 2024 Midyear Meeting Panel Questions

1. Should sections on scope of discovery, identification and preservation remain separate or be combined in some fashion, as these issues are closely related for mobile device data?
2. What level of transparency should be required for the technologies and methods used in mobile device data collection?
3. How can we best draft guidelines so that they are both useful and not subject to near-term obsolescence?
4. We have concluded that certain issues are not unique to mobile device data discovery and have chosen not to address them in this paper. We would like to know if anyone thinks we should include them:
 - a. Hyperlinked attachments
 - b. Pre-production redaction of data for privilege, PII or other reasons
5. To what degree should this paper attempt to address privacy issues on mobile devices? Should we make general reference to the issue (as we have currently done), or expand on the types of PI on mobile devices based on their nature and use?
6. How can we best make the distinction between corporate-owned or managed devices and personal devices such as those owned by individual plaintiffs?
