

"It was a mistake," said her mother. "I feel sad for the man and his family."


"Yes, the police thought he had a gun," said her father.

SOME WHITE PEOPLE STILL THINK MOST BLACK MEN AND **BOYS ARE** DANGEROUS




"Yes," answered her mother. "Back then many White people thought that they were better than Black people, even though it wasn't true."

Liz added: "Some White people still think most Black men and boys are dangerous, even though they're not."






BUT THIS PATTERN IS BEING NICE TO WHITE PEOPLE AND MEAN TO **BLACK PEOPLE**




AND THEY (COPS) DON'T LIKE BLACK

This is just one of many books at every grade level that indoctrinates children that if you're white you're a horrible oppressor and if you're non-white you're a helpless victim.

Public schools do not have a CRT curriculum. It's not that simple or obvious. It's in the culture. It's the CRT books that teachers are told to read. It's the seminars they take so in turn they bring in books like this for their students.
