You will also learn great strum patterns, finger picking patterns, and rhythmic and percussive effects to enhance your guitar playing.

4. Participants will utilize at least 4 elements of music with the guitar (including timbre, rhythm, tempo and dynamics) to meet client's needs during treatment (BCD II. A. 5. g.)
