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| Annotation | <ul style="list-style-type: none">☐ Ask learners to add notes, symbols, and drawing to the screen☐ Provide choices on PowerPoint, have learners select correct option |
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| Breakout Rooms | <ul style="list-style-type: none">☐ Create smaller groups for discussion of information and ideas☐ Use to review work or ideas☐ Brainstorm possible answers in smaller groups |
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| Chat | <ul style="list-style-type: none">☐ Ask learners to respond to introduction questions in chat☐ Ask for answers to review questions |
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| Emoticons | <ul style="list-style-type: none">☐ Ask learners to raise hand if they want to speak☐ Use thumbs up for agreement |
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| Poll | <ul style="list-style-type: none">☐ Use as quick learner assessment at the beginning of class☐ Use to check understanding throughout class☐ Review exercise at end of class |
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| Screen Sharing | <ul style="list-style-type: none">☐ Ask the learner to share their screen and demonstrate task in an application☐ Share your screen to show actual work process |
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| Whiteboard | <ul style="list-style-type: none">☐ Draw a grid, assign a square to each person, ask them to write key points they recall |
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
