Avraham is the pillar of chesed, kindness, Yitzchak is the pillar of gevurah, strength, and in Micha (7:20) we learn that Yaakov is the pillar of emet, truth. Most mefarshim, commentators, discuss the different incidents in Yaakov's life to determine how the actions of Yaakov were truthful in his deeds. There may be another way to understand the meaning of emet with reference to Yaakov.

In business a company will start with a creator or inventor of a product, then the idea is strengthened, and when the product is strong, the company expands and/or goes public. In many ways, the 'going public' of a company determines the validity and success of the In a similar vein, Avraham was the company. inventor/creator of Hashem's people and he did so with grace and chesed; it is also Hashem's chesed with Avraham that enabled Avraham to reach the dream. Yitzchak was the one who strengthened Avraham's creation - even with the possibility of losing his own life as noted by the akeidah. With both, Avraham and Yitzchak, an effort was put forth 'to work out the kinks' and to solidify the origination on monotheism. Yaakov was the one who took Judaism public; he was the one to expand the creation of being Hashem's people. He had substantially more children than his predecessors and all of the children were received within the faith. In addition, Yaakov spread the word not only in Eretz Yisrael, but he spent a significant amount of time outside the Holy Land thereby receiving the chatima, signature of the Jewish nation. As usual, there were some ups and downs when it came to sustenance and what his family endured. However, when it came to their way of life, it was a complete success as all of Yaakov's children prescribed to the same ideology of Avraham. This was the emet, truth of Yaakov by maintaining Avraham's original ideology even after going public as a true test of whether Avraham's ways will have longevity. Of course, here we are today, a testament of Yaakov's truth.

It is interesting to note that Knesset Israel is celebrating its 60 years anniversary. Yitzchak fathers Eisav and Yaakov at the age of 60. Eisav went on his own path.
