

PRESCHOOL

(Babies–Kindergarten)

JESUS HELPED HIS FRIENDS

JOHN 13:1-20

LIFE POINT: We can help our friends.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Babies–2s: God wants me to be a friend.

3s–PreK: God wants me to learn from Him.

Kindergarten: God wants people to follow Jesus' example.

LIVE IT OUT

Review the Bible story with your child. Remind her that Jesus helped His friends by washing their feet. Help your preschooler think of ways she can help and be kind to her friends.

KIDS

(1st–6th Grade)

JESUS RESISTED TEMPTATION

MATTHEW 4:1-11

LIFE POINT: We can follow Jesus's example to resist temptation.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Grades 1–2: God helps me obey what is written in the Bible.

Grades 3–4: God asks me to honor Him by choosing to do what is right and reject what is wrong.

Preteens: God commands people to obey Him. People can trust that He will help them resist temptation and give them self-control.

LIVE IT OUT

Remind your child that Jesus used Scripture to help resist the temptations of Satan. Help your child find Bible verses he can memorize to help him resist temptation. Write these verses down and memorize them together.

STUDENTS

(Middle–High School)

TEMPTATION VS. TRUTH

MATTHEW 4:1-11

THE QUESTION: How can Scripture help us deal with temptation?

THE POINT: When we face temptation, we can overcome it by knowing and applying Scripture.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

God gives us the Bible to deepen our relationship with Him and to resist the temptation to serve ourselves.

Take a moment this week to reflect on who or what influences your life. It's essential to surround yourself with people who speak the truth and encourage you to pursue Christ more intentionally.
