(Babies–Kindergarten)

JESUS PRAYED IN A GARDEN

MARK 14:32-40; LUKE 22:39-46

LIFE POINT: We can pray.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Babies–2s: God loves for me to talk to Him.

3s–PreK: God loves for me to pray.

Kindergarten: God wants people to pray.

LIVE IT OUT

Help your child say the Weekly Verse, “Lord, help us to pray. Luke 11:1.” Tell your child that God hears our prayers. Pray with your child to help him learn how to talk to God.

KIDS

(1st–6th Grade)

JESUS PRAYED IN A GARDEN

MARK 14:32-40; LUKE 22:39-46

LIFE POINT: We can follow Jesus’ example to pray.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Grades 1–2: God wants people to pray and read the Bible daily.

Grades 3–4: God wants people to communicate with Him through praying and reading the Bible daily.

Preteens: God wants people to communicate with Him and read the Bible daily.

LIVE IT OUT

Take time each day for a family prayer time. Choose a time when all members can be together. Talk about prayer concerns with your child or children. Pray together for the concern of each family member.

(Middle–High School)

NAVIGATING TOUGH MOMENTS

THE QUESTION: What can we learn from Jesus about how to pray during difficult times?

THE POINT: During difficult times, we can pray honestly and trust God’s plan.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

We all encounter difficult moments in life. In Jesus, we have a Savior we can pray to, trusting that He knows what is best for us.
