FAMILY CONNECTION

Let this resource help equip your family to live out your faith together from Sunday to everyday—regardless of age or stage.

PRESCHOOL

(Babies–Kindergarten)

JESUS LOVED ZACCHAEUS
LUKE 19:1-10

LIFE POINT: We can love all people.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Babies–2s: God wants me to be a friend.

3s–PreK: God helps me be kind to my friends.

Kindergarten: Jesus taught how God wants us to treat other people.

LIVE IT OUT

Review the Bible story with your child. Remind her that Jesus loves all people. Help her think of a child she knows who might need a friend. Encourage your child to show love to her new friend.

KIDS

(1st–6th Grade)

JESUS LOVED ZACCHAEUS
LUKE 19:1-10

LIFE POINT: We can follow Jesus' example to love others.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Grades 1–2: God helps me love others, both friends and enemies.

Grades 3–4: People can learn to love others as God loves them.

Preteens: People can take deliberate actions to grow in Christlikeness.

LIVE IT OUT

Guide your child to reach out to someone and form a new relationship. Encourage her to find someone she knows who has few friends. Help her understand that she is showing Jesus' love for this person.

STUDENTS

(Middle–High School)

LOOKING BEYOND THE SURFACE
LUKE 19:1-10

THE QUESTION: What does Jesus want us to understand about how we see and treat others?

THE POINT: Jesus sees and pursues us, giving us great worth regardless of how others perceive us.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

No one has the right to define who we are—our true identity comes only from God.

MOVING FORWARD

Take a moment this week to reflect on how you perceive others. When you first meet someone, do you focus on what you consider to be his or her “flaws”? Remember, the way we see others says a lot about how we view God.

ADULTS

(Young Adults–Senior Adults)

UNIT: How God Speaks
SESSION: God Speaks Through His Holy Spirit
1 CORINTHIANS 2:6-16

CONCEPT CATEGORY: View of God—BIBLE

IN FOCUS

The Holy Spirit guides us in knowing His will.

CONCEPT STATEMENT

LIVE IT OUT
