(Babies–Kindergarten)

JESUS BLESSED THE CHILDREN

MARK 10:13-16

LIFE POINT: We can be kind.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Babies–2s: God created me to make choices.

3s–PreK: God helps me to be kind to my friends.

Kindergarten: Jesus taught how God wants us to treat other people.

LIVE IT OUT

Print today's Bible verse, Hebrews 10:24 onto index cards, one word per card. Draw matching colored lines on matching cards. Help your child match the colors to put the verse in order. Say the verse together.

KIDS

(1st–6th Grade)

JESUS BLESSED THE CHILDREN

MARK 10:13-16

LIFE POINT: We can follow Jesus's example to treat all people as important.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Grades 1–2: People God's most important creation.

Grades 3–4: Each person is unique and of value to God.

Preteens: People are accountable to God for the way they treat other people.

LIVE IT OUT

Review the Bible story with your child. Remind her that Jesus found value in every person. Make a list of people your child knows. Help her pray for each person and ask God to help her know the worth of each one.

(Middle–High School)

KINGDOM LIFE WITH JESUS

MARK 10:13-16

THE QUESTION: What does Jesus teach us about God's kingdom?

THE POINT: God's kingdom is for all people who trust in Jesus and rely on Him.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

We are essential to the kingdom of God, as He uses us to reflect His image and glory.

MOVING FORWARD

Consider two things: Have you surrendered to Jesus in childlike faith? Have you received the greatest gift of all? If so, reflect on how relying on Christ impacts your daily life. In what ways or areas are you not fully relying on God but seeking the "blessings" of this world?

ROMANS 8:26-35

CONCEPT CATEGORY: View of God—BIBLE

IN FOCUS

God uses circumstances to guide us in His will.

CONCEPT STATEMENT

Through the Bible, we know God Himself, and we know how He expects us to live as followers of Christ and to experience His blessing.

LIVE IT OUT

Seek God's will with discernment, not by overthinking every circumstance. Trust Him to work through what you face, allowing each situation to deepen your faith and make you more like Christ.
