(Babies–Kindergarten)

JOSHUA AND CALEB

NUMBERS 13–14

LIFE POINT: We can obey
God even when others do not.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Babies–2s: God loves people.**3s–PreK:** God loves me even when I make
wrong choices.**Kindergarten:** God loves people even when
they make wrong choices.

LIVE IT OUT

Talk with your preschooler
about the word obey. Tell
him that the most important
thing we can do is obey
God. Remind him that God
still loves him, even if he
doesn't obey.

KIDS

(1st–6th Grade)

JOSHUA AND CALEB

NUMBERS 13–14

LIFE POINT: We can obey
God even when others
disobey.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Grades 1–2: God expects people to obey,
respect, and honor Him.**Grades 3–4:** God deserves respect,
obedience, and honor.**Preteens:** God deserves respect,
obedience, and honor. God wants us to live
for His glory.

LIVE IT OUT

Remind your child that Joshua
and Caleb knew the people
were disobeying argued
against them. Ask if he's ever
been tempted to sin by the
influence of others. Discuss
ways he can turn away from
this temptation.

(Middle–High School)

OBEDIENCE AND LEADERSHIP

NUMBERS 14:1–20

THE QUESTION: What influences
how we lead others?**THE POINT:** Our love for God
motivates our obedience to Him, not
others' decisions and responses.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: GOD

God is loving and righteous, grieves
the impact of sin on the world, and
will one day make right all that sin
has damaged.

MOVING FORWARD

Choose to lead by example, letting
your love for God guide your
actions rather than being swayed
by others' negativity or fear. Stay
faithful and encourage others to
trust and obey God, even when it's
unpopular. Pray for those who
struggle with unbelief.
