(Babies–Kindergarten)

ELIJAH ON MOUNT CARMEL

1 KINGS 18:1-39

LIFE POINT: We can obey God by worshiping Him.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Babies–2s: God is good.

3s–PreK: God tells me to sing and pray to Him.

Kindergarten: God tells people to worship Him.

LIVE IT OUT

Review the Bible story and talk about the ways the people worshiped God. Give your preschooler some simple instruments to play as you sing together some simple songs about worshiping God.

KIDS

(1st–6th Grade)

ELIJAH ON MOUNT CARMEL

1 KINGS 18:1-39

LIFE POINT: We can obey God by worshiping only Him.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Grades 1–2: God is real, the only true God.

Grades 3–4: God is worthy of worship.

Preteens: God expects people to worship Him with all their hearts, souls, minds, and strength.

LIVE IT OUT

Review with your child how God showed His power to the people on Mount Carmel. Help him memorize the Weekly Verse, 1 Kings 8:60. Remind your child that worship is for the One True God.

STUDENTS

(Middle–High School)

OBEDIENCE AND OUR VIEW OF GOD

1 KINGS 18:20-39

THE QUESTION: How does what we think about God affect the way we follow Him?

THE POINT: Our obedience to God reflects our beliefs and dependence on Him.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: GOD

God (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) is eternal, and although He is not bound by time, He chooses to operate in it to relate to us.

MOVING FORWARD

You can choose to fully follow God by turning away from anything that competes for His place in your life and making daily decisions that put Him first. Consistent prayer, stepping out in faith when God leads you, and openly declaring your dependence on Him shows your trust that He alone is worthy and able.

ADULTS

(Young Adults–Senior Adults)

UNIT: The Beauty of Forgiveness

SESSION: The Cry for Forgiveness

PSALM 51:1-13

CONCEPT CATEGORY: View of Self—Salvation.

IN FOCUS

When we sin, we sin against God—so only He can forgive us.

CONCEPT STATEMENT

Salvation includes the forgiveness of sin through faith in Jesus, freeing us from guilt and enabling us to extend genuine forgiveness to others.

LIVE IT OUT

When you sin, come to God in repentance. He forgives, cleanses, and restores. Receive His grace, remember who you are in Him, and consider how your story might help others return to Him.
