

FAMILY CONNECTION

Let this resource help equip your family to live out your faith together from Sunday to everyday—regardless of age or stage.

PRESCHOOL

(Babies–Kindergarten)

DANIEL IN THE LIONS' DEN
DANIEL 6

LIFE POINT: We can obey God wherever we go.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Babies–2s: God helps me.

3s–PreK: God helps people.

Kindergarten: God helps and provides for people.

LIVE IT OUT

Remind your child that Daniel obeyed God when he was far away from home. Help your child think of ways to obey God when she is in school, shopping, riding in the car, and so forth.

KIDS

(1st–6th Grade)

DANIEL IN THE LIONS' DEN
DANIEL 6

LIFE POINT: We can obey God wherever we go.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Grades 1–2: God is everywhere.

Grades 3–4: God is everywhere at all times.

Preteens: God is omnipresent—He is everywhere at all times.

LIVE IT OUT

Help your child memorize Joshua 1:9. Tell her she can say this verse to remind herself that God is always with her and will help her obey Him.

STUDENTS

(Middle–High School)

OBEDIENCE AND CHARACTER
DANIEL 6:1-23

THE QUESTION: Why is it important to follow God wherever He leads us?

THE POINT: Pursuing God in prayer and obedience matters because it shapes who we are and helps us follow wherever He leads.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: GOD

God communicates to us through His Word and He hears and answers when we pray; our spiritual maturity grows when we practice spiritual disciplines.

MOVING FORWARD

Set aside time each day for focused prayer, seeking God's guidance and strength before facing your daily challenges. Practice obedience in the small decisions, choosing to honor God in both words and actions, even when no one is watching.

(Young Adults–Senior Adults)

PSALM 103:1-13

CONCEPT CATEGORY: View of Self—Salvation.

IN FOCUS

Forgiveness reflects the character of God.

CONCEPT STATEMENT

Salvation includes the forgiveness of sin through faith in Jesus, freeing us from guilt and enabling us to extend genuine forgiveness to others.

LIVE IT OUT

Remember that God has forgiven your sins. Let gratitude shape your worship, your mindset, and your witness. Reflect on His grace, give thanks, and be ready to share His forgiveness with others.
