(Babies–Kindergarten)

RUTH AND BOAZ

RUTH 1–4

LIFE POINT: We can love and help our family members.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Babies–2s: Family members love one another.

3s–PreK: God wants family members to love and help one another.

Kindergarten: God wants families to show love, respect, and kindness to one another.

LIVE IT OUT

As you review the Bible story with your child, talk how Ruth chose to help Naomi. Help your child make a list of ways he helps at home, at school, or at church. Say the Weekly Verse together: “Show love to one another. Romans 12:10.”

KIDS

(1st–6th Grade)

RUTH AND BOAZ

RUTH 1–4

LIFE POINT: We can love and help our family members.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Grades 1–2: God’s plan for families is for them to love, respect, and help one another.

Grades 3–4: God’s plan is for all family members to work together so that God is honored by their family.

Preteens: God’s plan is for each person to make a positive contribution to her family.

LIVE IT OUT

Review the Bible story and the Weekly Bible Verse, Romans 12:10. Talk how Ruth helped Naomi. Help your child think of ways your family show love for one another. Challenge your child to perform a loving action for a family member.

STUDENTS

(Middle–High School)

REFLECTING GOD

EXODUS 1:15–2:10

THE QUESTION: How can our choices help our family see that God is real?

THE POINT: Following God’s will helps our family understand who He is and His promises.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: FAMILY

Families are a part of God’s plan for filling the earth with His image bearers and are responsible for providing for the needs of their members.

MOVING FORWARD

Take some time this week to journal your thoughts to God. Simply write down your thoughts to Him as if you were praying. Be honest with God about the difficulties and fears that come with trying to follow His will daily, and ask Him to give you the faith to trust Him alone.

(Young Adults–Senior Adults)

SESSION: The Reason for Forgiveness

ISAIAH 43:1–7, 21–25

CONCEPT CATEGORY: View of Self—Salvation.

IN FOCUS

God loves us and wants to restore us for His glory.

CONCEPT STATEMENT

Salvation includes the forgiveness of sin through faith in Jesus, freeing us from guilt and enabling us to extend genuine forgiveness to others.

LIVE IT OUT

Practice ongoing repentance with honesty and humility. Ask God to reveal sin to you, then confess and turn from it. Trust in His restoration, and seek support from others as you pursue lasting change.
