ABRAM AND LOT

GENESIS 13

LIFE POINT: We can get along and help our family members

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Babies–2s: Families love one another.

3s–PreK: God wants family members to love and help one another.

Kindergarten: God wants families to show love, respect, and kindness to one another.

LIVE IT OUT

Use a sheet of paper to make a helping chart for your child. Help him think of ways he can show love by helping members of your family and print them on the chart. Let your child put a sticker on the chart any time he helps.

JESUS VISITED MARY AND MARTHA

LUKE 10:38–42

LIFE POINT: We can get along and help our family members

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Grades 1–2: God loves families and wants families to love and forgive each other when difficult things happen.

Grades 3–4: God loves families even when family members sin. God is always ready to forgive.

Preteens: God loves families even when they are broken. God wants all believers to act as the family of God and help others in difficult times.

LIVE IT OUT

Review the Bible story with your child. Ask what caused the problem between Mary and Martha. Say people can disagree, but it is important to get along and help one another. Discuss some ways to solve these disagreements.

REFLECTING PROVISION

RUTH 3

THE QUESTION: How does God want us to treat our family?

THE POINT: God wants us to help care for, love, and provide for our family.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: FAMILY

Because we are meant to live in relationship, God's design is that we would experience love, acceptance, support, and guidance through our earthly family.

MOVING FORWARD

This week, practice living as if God is truly in control of all the events of daily life and that He's working everything for the good of His people (Rom. 8:28). The result of this is a renewed sense of peace and confidence, even on difficult days.
