

FAMILY CONNECTION

Let this resource help equip your family to live out your faith together from Sunday to everyday—regardless of age or stage.

PRESCHOOL

(Babies–Kindergarten)

PRISCILLA AND AQUILA

ACTS 18:1-3,18-28

LIFE POINT: We can tell others about Jesus with our family members.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Babies–2s: God made families.

3s–PreK: God wants families to love and help one another.

Kindergarten: Families worship God together.

LIVE IT OUT

Clap with your child while saying: “T–E–L–L, I can tell about Jesus.” Name a person to tell about Jesus. Repeat the chant, encouraging your child to name someone she could tell about Jesus, adding other names as you continue.

KIDS

(1st–6th Grade)

PRISCILLA AND AQUILA

ACTS 18:1-3,18-28

LIFE POINT: We can serve and worship God with our family members.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: PEOPLE

Grades 1–2: God wants families to worship at home and other places.

Grades 3–4: God wants families to worship together to help them grow stronger in their faith.

Preteens: God wants families to have an attitude of worship.

LIVE IT OUT

Print on index cards the words and reference of Joshua 24:15. Place the cards around your house and, as a family, commit to memorizing and discussing this Bible verse. Pray together, asking God to help you show your love for Jesus to others.

STUDENTS

(Middle–High School)

REFLECTING DEEPER FAITH

ACTS 18:18-28

THE QUESTION: Why is it important for families to remain committed to worship and grow in faith?

THE POINT: When families worship God, it can deepen the faith of those around them.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING: FAMILY

We are called to honor God in the ways that we treat our family. Therefore, we should work intentionally to show family members love.

MOVING FORWARD

This week, think of one area of biblical understanding you want to grow in. After talking to your pastor or a leader at your church, make a plan to grow in your knowledge of God and His Word. As your knowledge grows, be mindful to give God the proper response of worship.

(Young Adults–Senior Adults)

SESSION: The Evidence of Forgiveness

MATTHEW 18:21-35

CONCEPT CATEGORY: View of Self—Salvation.

IN FOCUS

Experiencing God’s forgiveness is reflected in our willingness to forgive others.

CONCEPT STATEMENT

Salvation includes the forgiveness of sin through faith in Jesus, freeing us from guilt and enabling us to extend genuine forgiveness to others.

LIVE IT OUT

Because you have been forgiven, choose to forgive others. Pray for those who are hard to forgive, pursue reconciliation where possible, and trust God to help you extend the grace you have received.
