BIBLE STORY NUGGETS

- God made people.
- The people lived in a beautiful garden.
- God told the people what to do.
- The people did not obey God.

God created the perfect home for Adam and Eve. Selfish desires and curiosity caused the man and woman to make a bad choice. At church today your child heard about Adam and Eve in the garden. Babies and toddlers heard that God wants people to love and obey Him. Help your child begin to understand that God knows what is best for us, and He wants us to obey Him.

ADAM AND EVE'S CHOICE

Genesis 2:15-17; 3

God made a beautiful garden with flowers and trees and streams. God told Adam to live in the garden and take care of it. God made Eve to be with Adam and help him.

God had one rule for Adam and Eve: Do not eat fruit from the special tree in the middle of the garden. "You may eat from any tree but the special tree," God said.

But Eve made a choice. She decided to taste the fruit from the special tree. Then Adam tasted it, too.

Right away, Adam and Eve knew they had done wrong. They had disobeyed God's instructions.

God told Adam and Eve they could no longer live in the beautiful garden.

FAMILY ADVENTURE FOLLOW THE BIBLE

Put a Bible on a small blanket. Pull the blanket as you coax your baby to scoot or crawl to the Bible. When he gets near, pull the blanket to encourage him to continue crawling. Guide your baby to touch, hold, or turn the Bible page at Deuteronomy 11:1. Say: "The Bible tells us to love God and obey Him."

FAMILY ADVENTURE PULL WEEDS

Walk outdoors with your toddler. Help her find and pull the weeds in your yard or garden. Talk about Adam and Eve and the beautiful garden God gave them. God told the man and woman to take care of the garden.

Hide this card under a plant. When your child finds the card, point to the picture and tell the Bible story.
