

Unit 2: God Formed a Nation

Unit Description:

God's plan to save people through Jesus began to take shape when God chose to bless Abraham's family by grace. He made a covenant with Abraham and promised him a new home and a large family. God also promised Abraham that one day all the people of the world would be blessed through his family—a promise that points to Jesus.

Big Picture Question:

Story Point: God's covenant with Abraham continued with Isaac's family.
