## SOCIAL DISTANCING ACTIVITY ADJUSTMENTS

Unit 31 • Session 1

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**A Note for Leaders:** Because each volume of *The Gospel Project for Preschool* is written several months in advance of its suggested use dates and is available for purchase for three years, the activities in the leader guides do not reflect the current social distancing guideline requirements of many preschool ministries. However, we want to do all we can to help you, especially in these challenging times, so we have provided activity adjustments as needed below. Please note that we cannot anticipate the various policies and needs of every ministry, so even these adaptations and replacements may need further revision for your context.

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### FIND PETER

Tip: Sanitize or replace the person figure between each use. You may choose to send only one or two children at a time to find the figure

### PRAY FOR PEOPLE GROUPS ADJUSTMENT

Lay a world map poster on the floor. Invite a child to stand a few feet away from it and hand him a beanbag to toss onto the map. Read the name of the place where the beanbag lands. Lead children in prayer for the people of that place to know Jesus as Lord. Invite another child to toss a new beanbag onto a different place on the map. Read where it lands and pray for the people there. Continue tossing beanbags and praying for people groups around the world

### PLAY OUT THE STORY

Tip: Provide enough supplies for every three children. Assign one child in each group to build Cornelius' house, one child to build the house where Peter was praying, and another child to play out the vision with the animals on the cloth.
