SOCIAL DISTANCING ACTIVITY ADJUSTMENTS

A Note for Leaders: Because each volume of *The Gospel Project for Preschool* is written several months in advance of its suggested use dates and is available for purchase for three years, the activities in the leader guides do not reflect the current social distancing guideline requirements of many preschool ministries. However, we want to do all we can to help you, especially in these challenging times, so we have provided activity adjustments as needed below. Please note that we cannot anticipate the various policies and needs of every ministry, so even these adaptations and replacements may need further revision for your context.

MAKE A PEOPLE COLLAGE

Tip: Provide a sheet of paper for each child. When children have finished covering their papers with people pictures, tape the sheets together to form a large cross.

BUILD CHURCH BUILDINGS ADJUSTMENT

Print and cut apart the “Places of Worship” cards. Add a picture of your church building or where your church meets if possible. Comment that in today’s Bible story, the church was just beginning. People may have met in homes, outside, and in other places. Name churches in your area that meet in non-traditional places such as schools, movie theaters, or other buildings. Provide a set of blocks for every one to two children in separate areas of the room. Encourage preschoolers to build a church building. Pray, thanking God for your church and other churches in your area.
