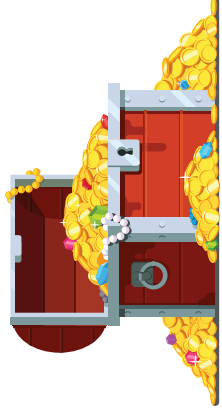


Ephesus

when it is hard.



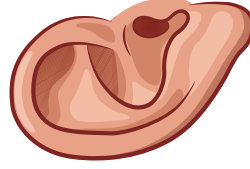
Thyatira

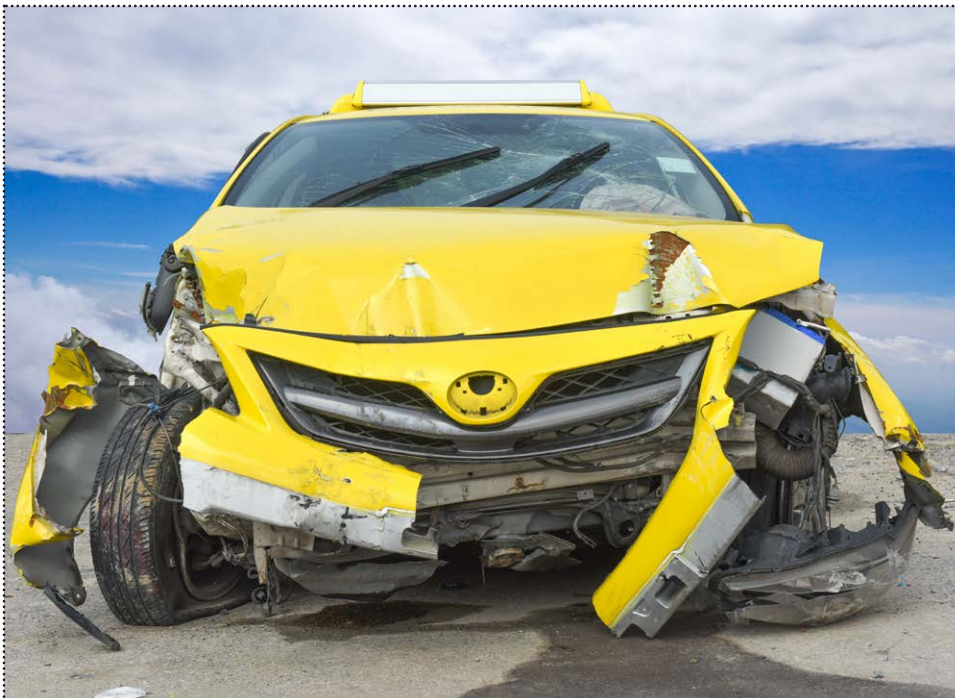
More about the Singermans
