


SESSION AT A GLANCE



PREPARE

- **Read the Leader Bible Study and Bible story** including the Expected Response. For additional help for preparing, visit www.gospelproject.com.
- **Familiarize yourself with the worship session content**, noting if the additional activity will be used.
- **Gather and prepare worship session supplies**, including posters, videos, and activity printables as needed.
- **Contact families and pray for your kids** during the week.



LEARN

- **Help kids learn through worship.** Show kids that worshiping God is an important way of how we get to know Him. During this portion of the worship session, focus on what kids should believe—clarify what worship is, why it is important, and what God wants our kids to know about the Bible story and Big Picture Question and Answer.




LOVE

- **Help kids love with worship.** Help kids grow in their love for God and expand their desire to praise Him. During this portion of the worship session, focus on what kids should feel—help them think about and understand their emotional responses to God, and guide them to channel those emotions in positive ways.



LIVE

- **Help kids live in worship.** Encourage kids to take action to worship God more fully throughout the week. During this portion of the worship session, focus on what kids should do—how they can live differently based on their growing understanding of and love for God.



NOTABLE FEATURES

Expected Response

The expected response is one of many ways that kids might respond to the week's Bible story. The expected response will help kids explore their response to the gospel and how to process their thoughts and feelings in healthy ways.

Suggested Times

Each session is designed to be completed in 60–75 minutes but can be shortened or lengthened as needed.

Big Truth Sessions

Each unit ends with a Big Truth Session that goes into more depth of the unit's Big Picture Question and Answer. These sessions use a Bible story that best helps illustrate the Big Truth covered. Think of these sessions as a time to reinforce and clarify what the kids have been learning in the unit.

Make it fit

Each worship session is designed for all of the kids to stay together the full time, but it can be adapted easily to incorporate small groups as well.
