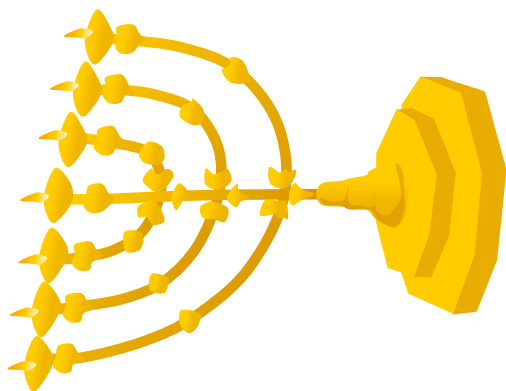

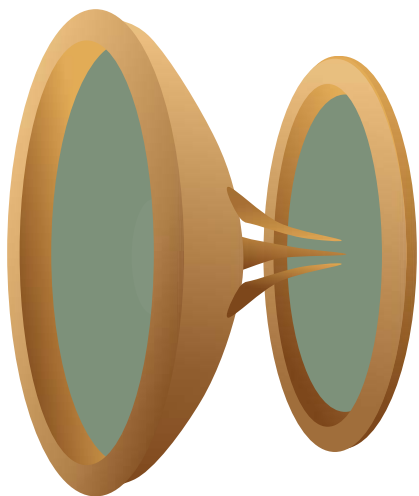

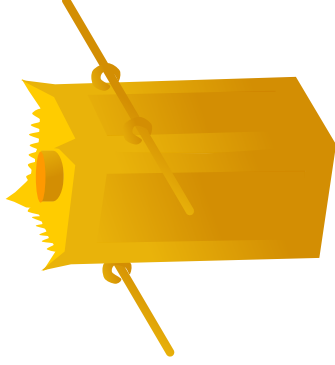
1. Lampstand: Gave light inside the tent since there were no windows.



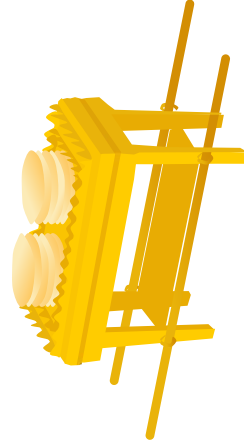
2. Laver: A large basin or bowl used by priests to wash their hands before serving in the tabernacle.



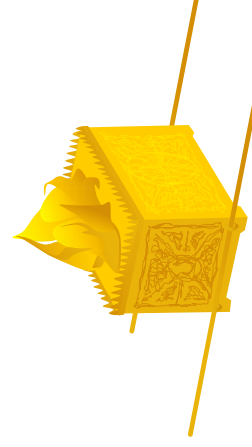
3. Altar of Sacrifice: A bronze altar where the people gave animal offerings to the Lord



4. Incense Altar: This altar made sweet smells produced by sweet smelling spices inside the tent.

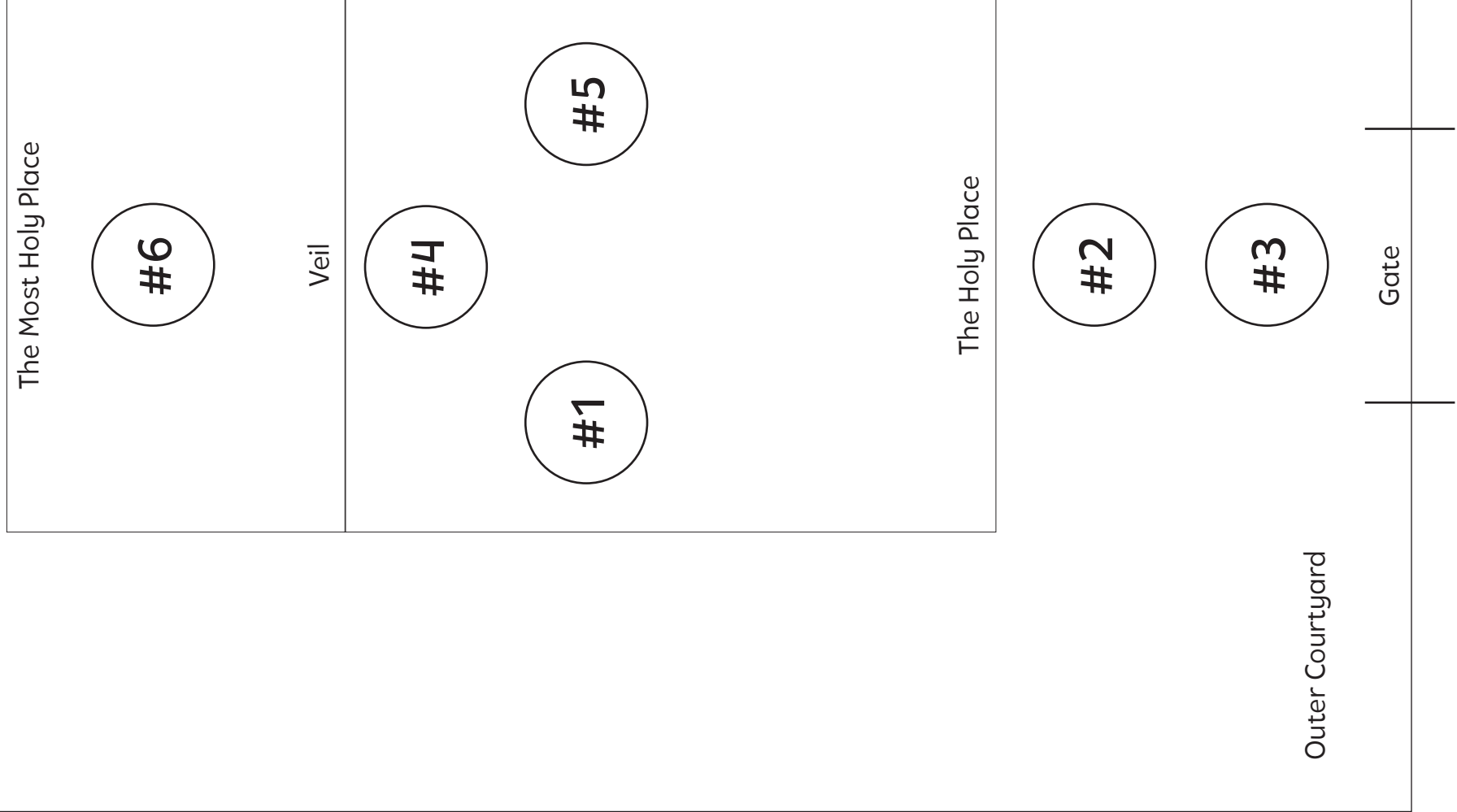


5. Table of Showbread: Where the priests ate God's bread in his tabernacle.

Samuel Zwemer (zuh-WAY-mer) was one of the first missionaries to Muslim people. Samuel was born in the United States. When he was a little baby, his mother prayed that God would make him a missionary, and God did! Samuel knew he wanted to go to the place where the Muslim people were. Samuel felt sad for all of the Muslim people because they didn't know Jesus.

Samuel moved to a faraway country to tell Muslims about Jesus. It wasn't an easy job. But Samuel never stopped believing that it was exactly where God had called him to go.

Samuel wrote lots of books during his life, and he came back to the United States and talked to young people about going to faraway places to teach Muslims about Jesus. Many young people became missionaries because of his stories and the things he wrote.

Samuel lived to be 84 years old. He never stopped teaching young people about missions.
