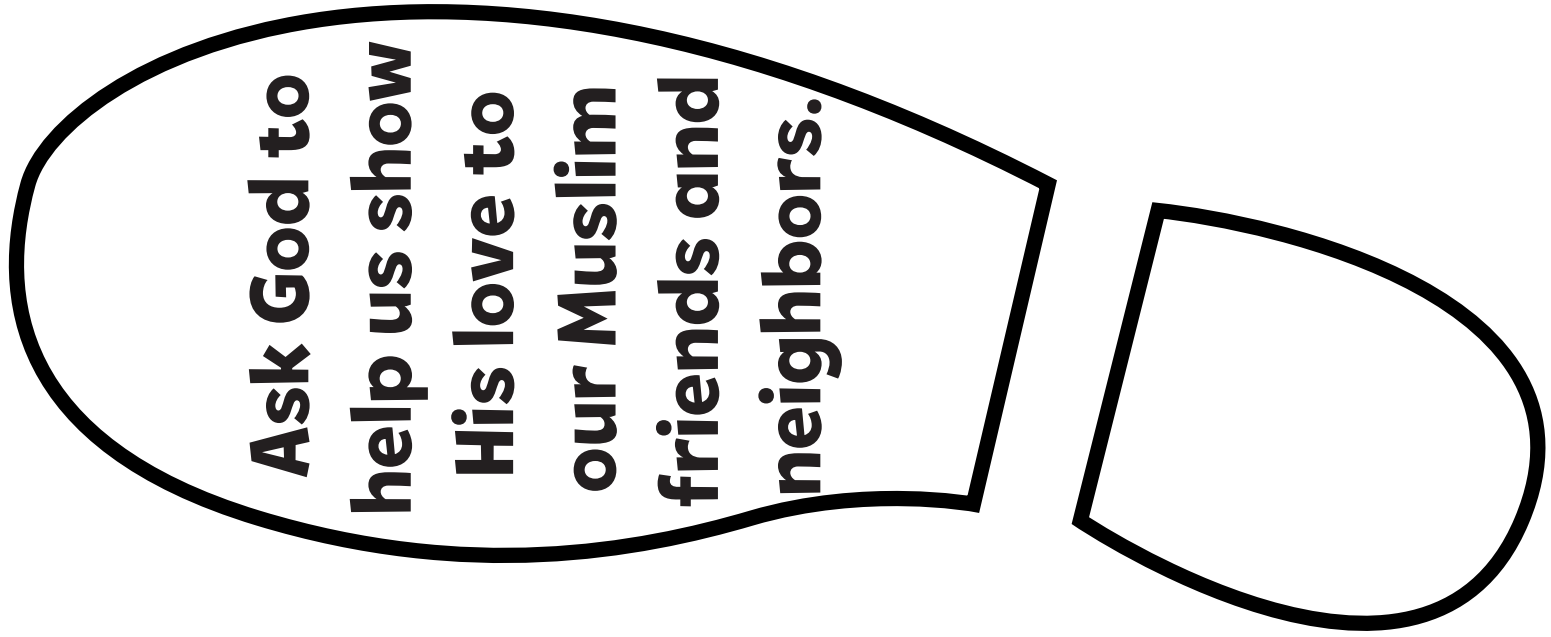
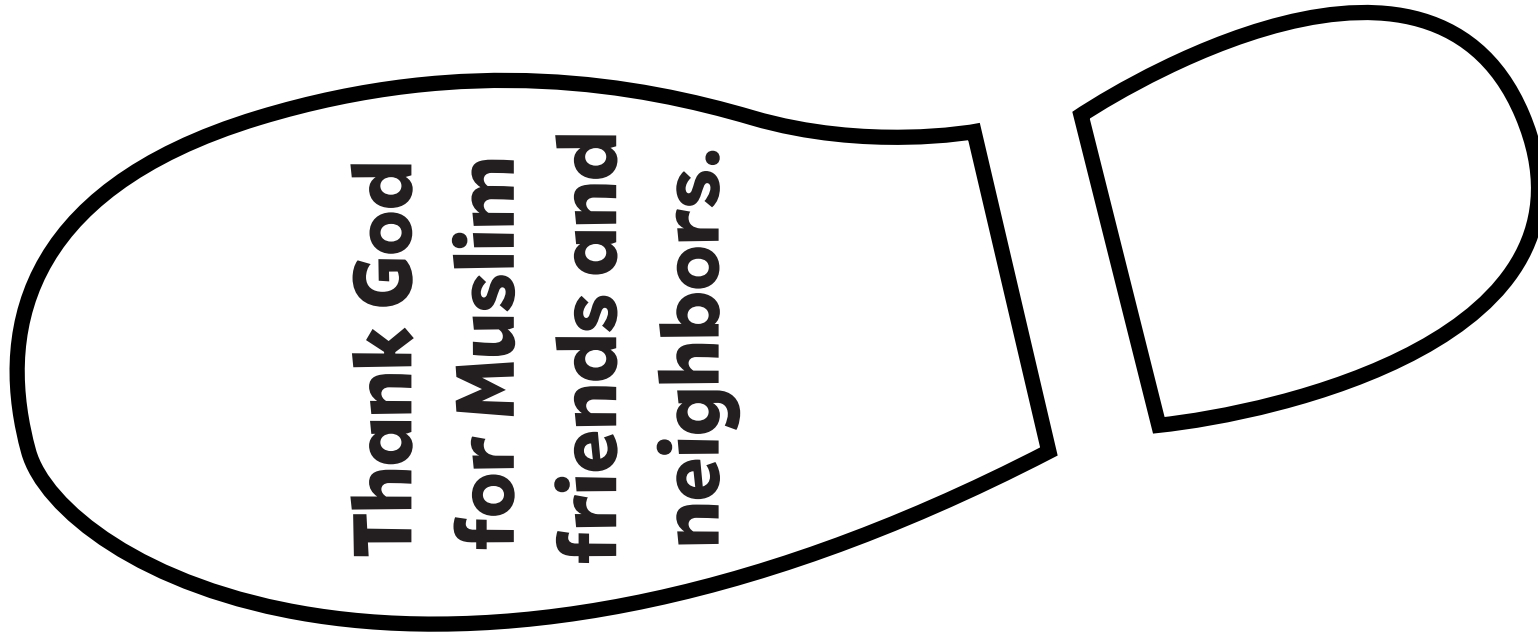
Samuel lived to be 84 years old. He never stopped teaching young people about missions.

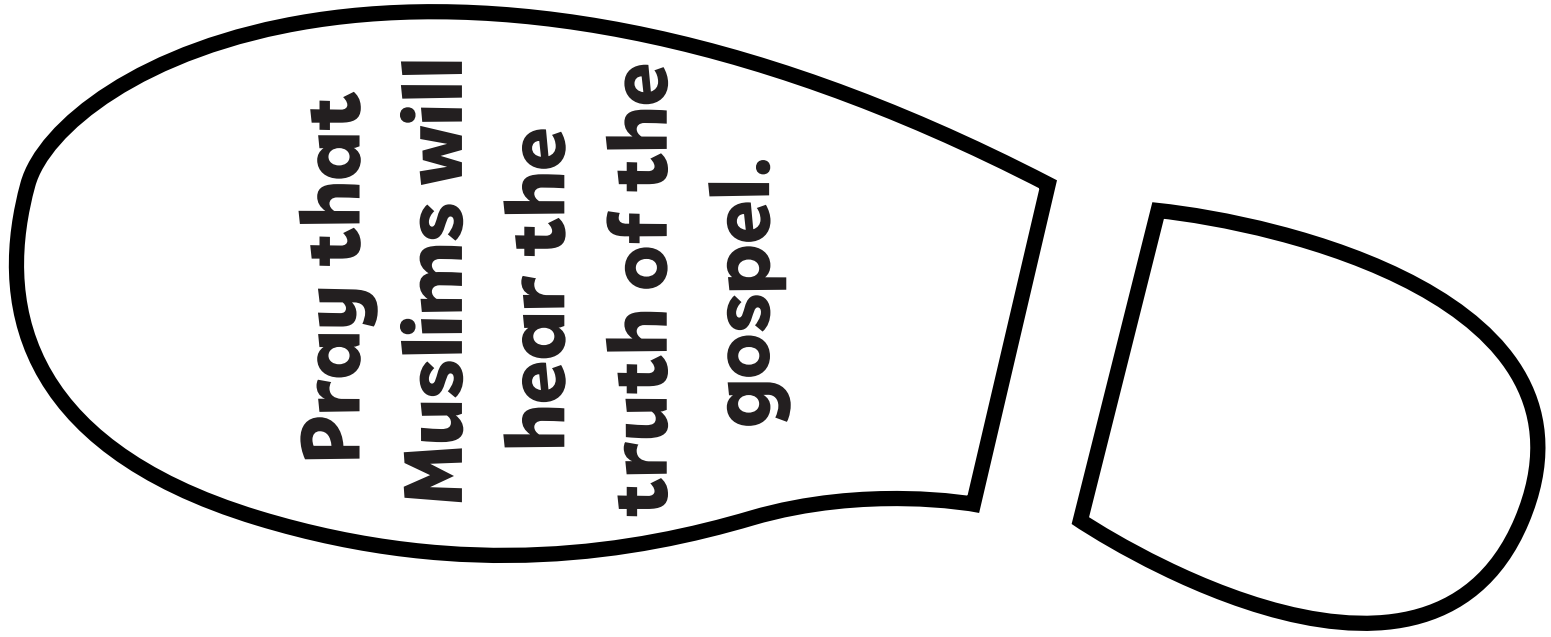
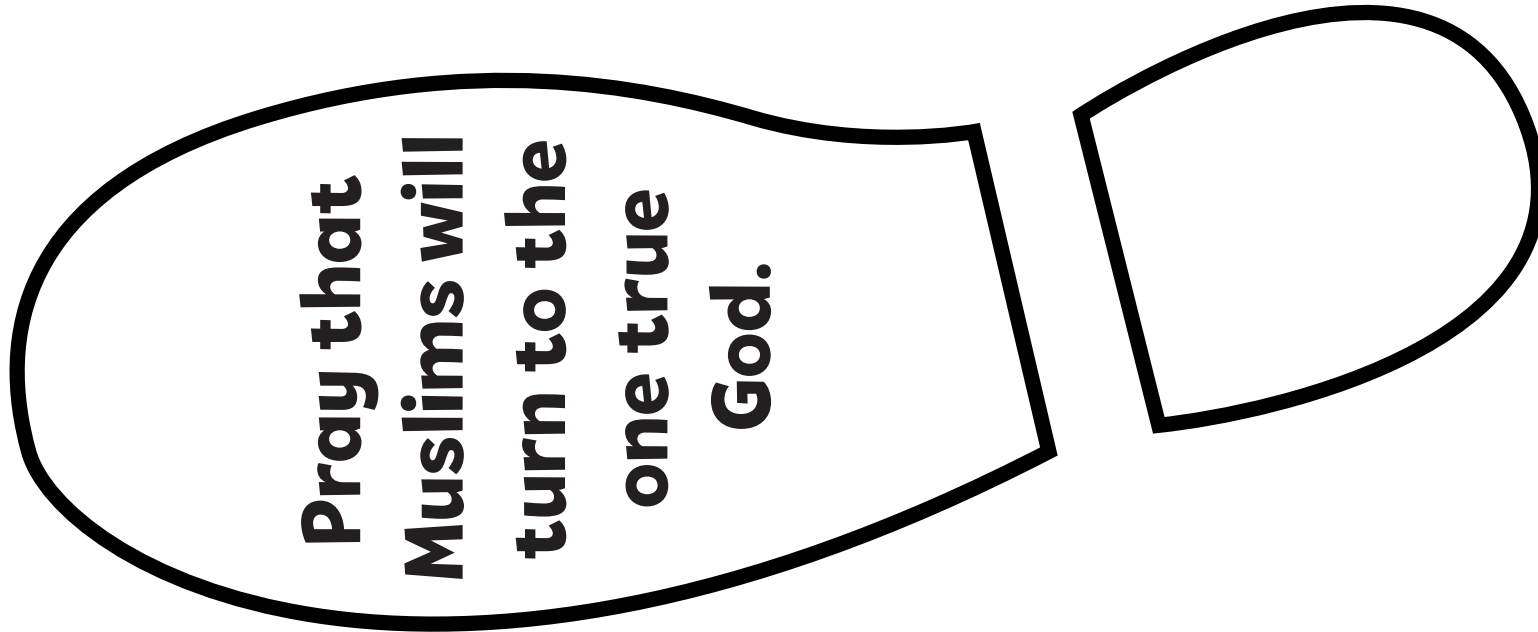


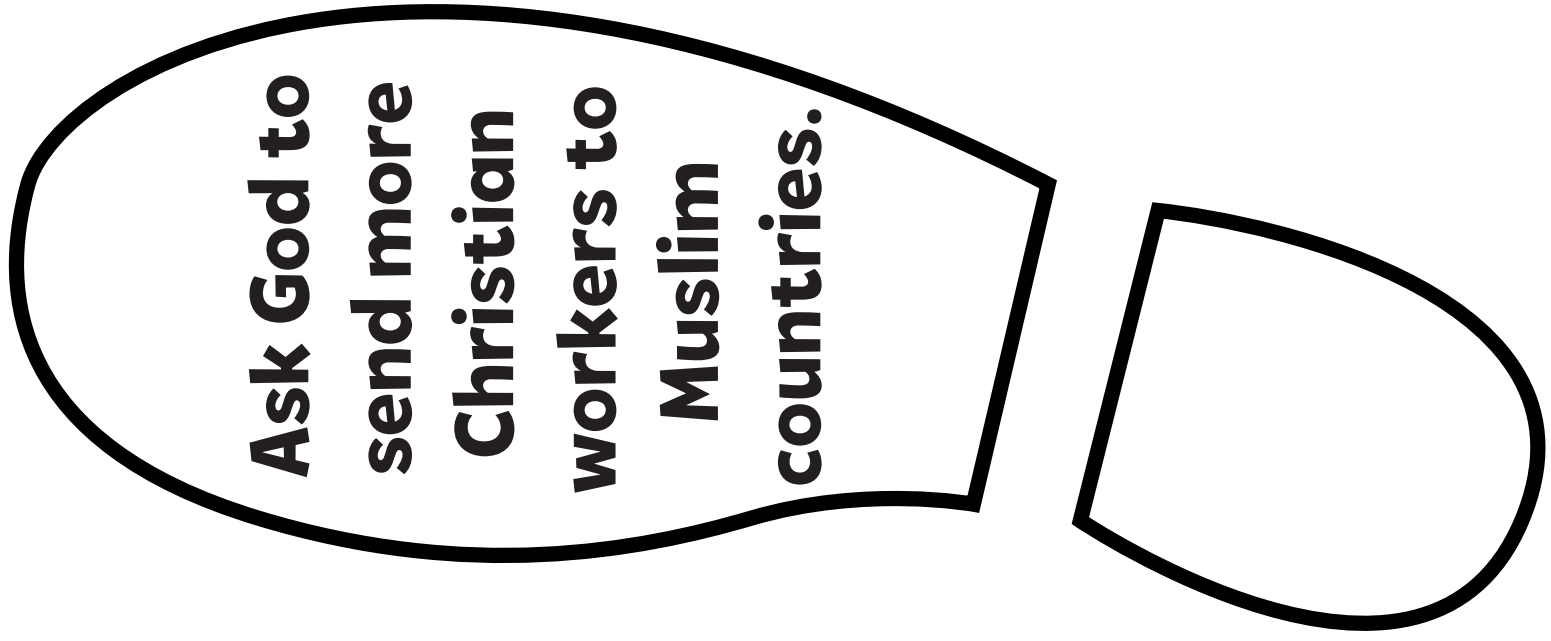
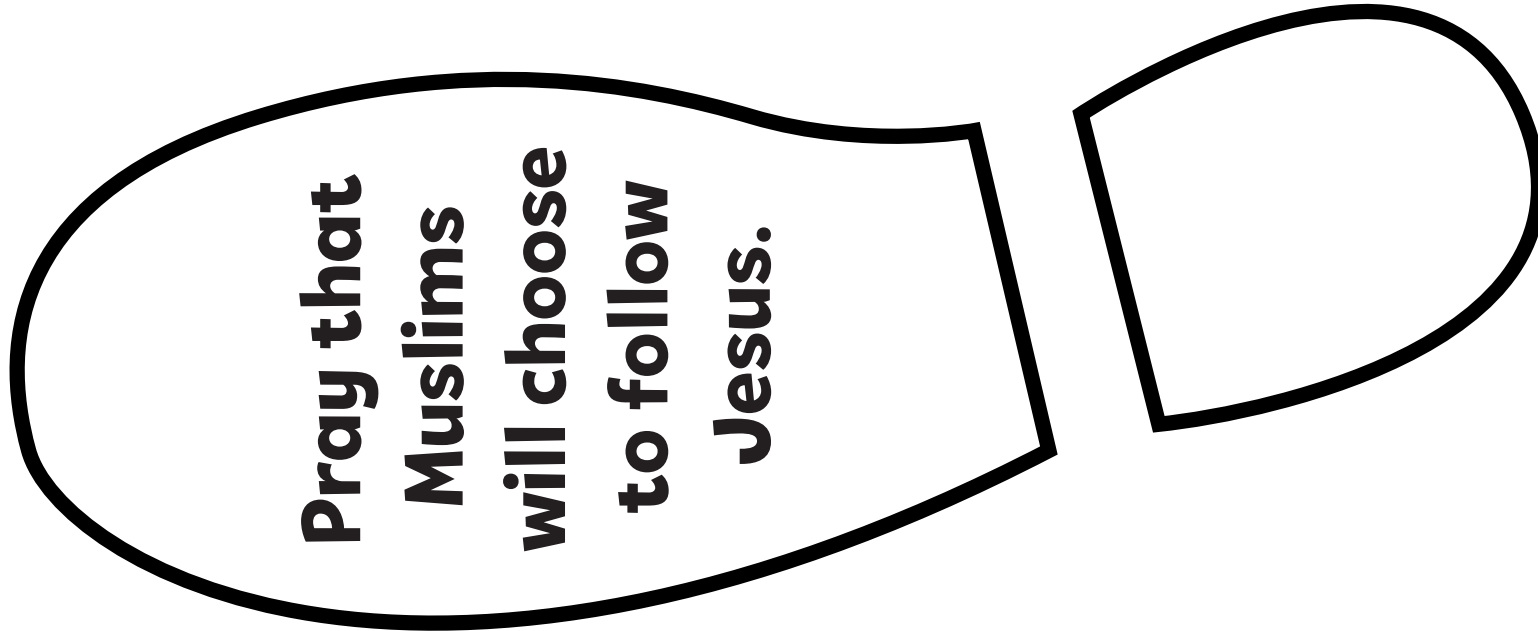
