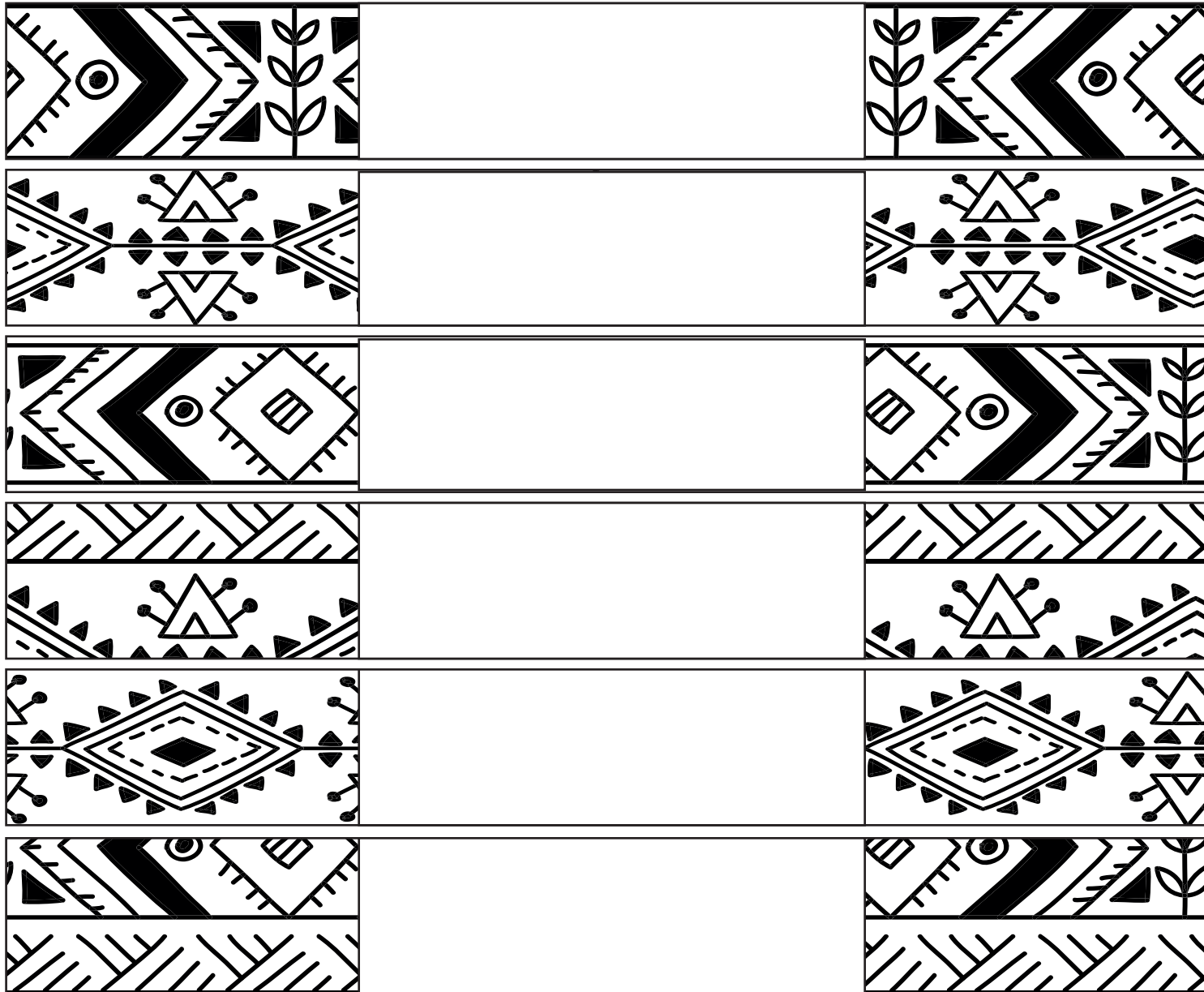

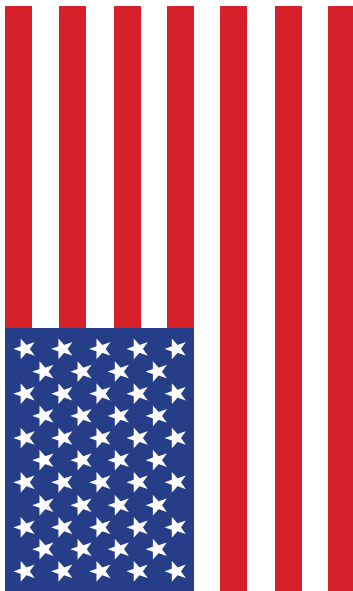

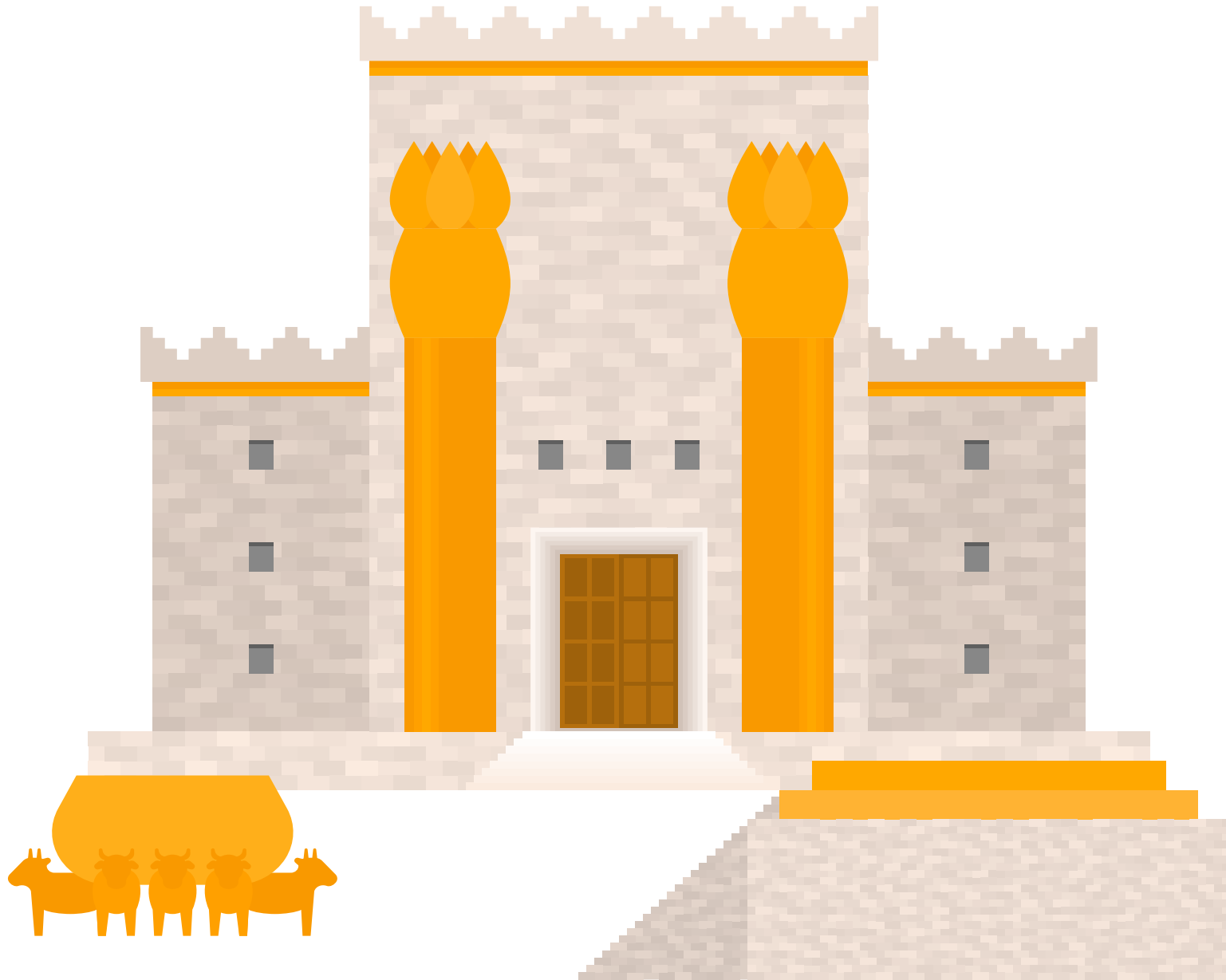
WHAT SPECIAL INTERESTS AND ABILITIES COULD YOU USE TO TELL OTHERS ABOUT JESUS?

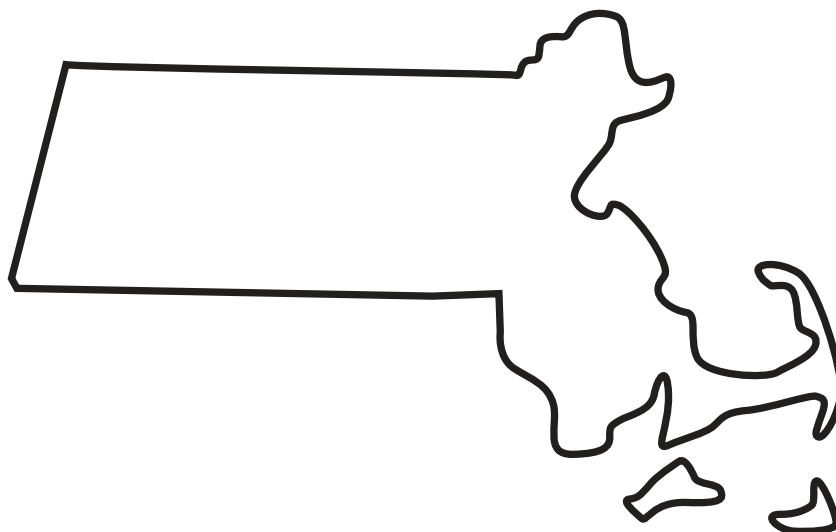
