## **POINT 1: THE HERALD PREPARES FOR THE SON**

(MARK 1:1-6).

<sup>1</sup> The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

<sup>2</sup> As it is written in Isaiah the prophet: See, I am sending my messenger ahead of you; he will prepare your way. <sup>3</sup> A voice of one crying out in the wilderness: Prepare the way for the Lord; make his paths straight! <sup>4</sup> John came baptizing in the wilderness and proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. <sup>5</sup> The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem were going out to him, and they were baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins.

<sup>6</sup> John wore a camel-hair garment with a leather belt around his waist and ate locusts and wild honey.

## **POINT 2: THE HERALD POINTS TO THE SON** (MARK 1:7-8).

<sup>7</sup> He proclaimed, “One who is more powerful than I am is coming after me. I am not worthy to stoop down and untie the strap of his sandals. <sup>8</sup> I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.”

## **POINT 3: THE HERALD BAPTIZES THE SON** (MARK 1:9-11).

<sup>9</sup> In those days Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized in the Jordan by John. <sup>10</sup> As soon as he came up out of the water, he saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. <sup>11</sup> And a voice came from heaven: “You are my beloved Son; with you I am well-pleased.”
