POINT 1: THE SON OF GOD RESTS IN THE CARE OF HIS FATHER (MARK 4:35-38).

³⁵ On that day, when evening had come, he told them, "Let's cross over to the other side of the sea." ³⁶ So they left the crowd and took him along since he was in the boat. And other boats were with him. ³⁷ A great windstorm arose, and the waves were breaking over the boat, so that the boat was already being swamped. ³⁸ He was in the stern, sleeping on the cushion. So they woke him up and said to him, "Teacher! Don't you care that we're going to die?"

POINT 2: THE SON OF GOD EXERTS AUTHORITY OVER HIS CREATION (MARK 4:39).

³⁹ He got up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Silence! Be still!" The wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

POINT 3: THE SON OF GOD CALLS FOR FAITH FROM HIS FOLLOWERS (MARK 4:40-41).

⁴⁰ Then he said to them, "Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?" ⁴¹ And they were terrified and asked one another, "Who then is this? Even the wind and the sea obey him!"
