## **POINT 1: JESUS IS THE MESSIAH WHO FULFILLS PROPHECY** (MATT. 21:1-5).

<sup>1</sup> When they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage at the Mount of Olives, Jesus then sent two disciples, <sup>2</sup> telling them, “Go into the village ahead of you. At once you will find a donkey tied there with her colt. Untie them and bring them to me. <sup>3</sup> If anyone says anything to you, say that the Lord needs them, and he will send them at once.” <sup>4</sup> This took place so that what was spoken through the prophet might be fulfilled: <sup>5</sup> Tell Daughter Zion, “See, your King is coming to you, gentle, and mounted on a donkey, and on a colt, the foal of a donkey.”

## **POINT 2: JESUS IS THE KING WHO RECEIVES ADORATION** (MATT. 21:6-8).

<sup>6</sup> The disciples went and did just as Jesus directed them. <sup>7</sup> They brought the donkey and the colt; then they laid their clothes on them, and he sat on them. <sup>8</sup> A very large crowd spread their clothes on the road; others were cutting branches from the trees and spreading them on the road.

## **POINT 3: JESUS IS THE SON OF DAVID WHO BRINGS SALVATION** (MATT. 21:9-11).

<sup>9</sup> Then the crowds who went ahead of him and those who followed shouted: ‘Hosanna’ to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! ‘Hosanna’ in the highest heaven! <sup>10</sup> When he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was in an uproar, saying, “Who is this?” <sup>11</sup> The crowds were saying, “This is the prophet Jesus from Nazareth in Galilee.”
