

## Volume 10 (Winter 2023-24) Kids Sermon Outlines

### UNIT 28, SESSION 1 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE

**Jesus revealed Himself to the disciples (Luke 24:39-43):** Jesus showed them His hands and feet and invited the disciples to draw close to Him.

**We can know Jesus through the Scriptures (Luke 24:44-49):** Jesus reminded the disciples that He was fulfilling what was written in Scripture.

**Knowing Jesus gives us peace (Luke 24:36-38):** Jesus' presence in our lives can bring peace and quiet doubts.

### UNIT 28, SESSION 2 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE

**Jesus meets us in our doubts (John 20:25-27):** Jesus came to Thomas and showed him where the nails were in His hands so that Thomas would believe.

**Jesus calls us to faith (John 20:27):** Jesus invited Thomas to have faith and He invites us to do the same.

**Faith is believing even what we cannot see (John 20:29):** Thomas believed because He saw Jesus, but Jesus tells us to believe even when we cannot see.

### UNIT 28, SESSION 3 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE

**Peter was confident in Jesus' mercy (John 21:7):** Even though Peter previously denied knowing Jesus, he still felt comfortable enough to swim to Jesus.

**Jesus forgave Peter for denying Him (John 21:15-17):** Jesus asked Peter three times if he loved Him, but Jesus did not withhold forgiveness.

**We are part of God's plan even though we sin (John 21:17-19):** Peter sinned when he rejected Jesus, but God still used Peter to grow His kingdom and bring Him glory.

### UNIT 28, SESSION 4 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE

**Jesus knows us and we can know Him (Matthew 28:16-18):** Jesus came near to the disciples, even when some of them were doubting.

**Jesus calls us to build God's kingdom (Matthew 28:19-20):** We are called to make disciples of all nations and share the truths that Jesus has taught us.

**Jesus is always with us (Matthew 28:20):** Jesus promises to be with us to the end of the age.

### UNIT 29, SESSION 1 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE

**Jesus gives us the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:4-5):** Even though Jesus returned to heaven, He gave us a special helper in the Holy Spirit.

**Jesus gives us power to complete the job He gave us (Acts 1:7-8):** The Holy Spirit gives us the power to tell others about the good news of Jesus.

**Jesus will return one day (Acts 1:9-11):** Jesus ascended into heaven, but one day He will return to earth.

### UNIT 29, SESSION 2 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE

**The disciples were steadfast amid a trial (Acts 1:12-14):** After Jesus returned to heaven, the disciples went to Jerusalem and prayed while they waited for Jesus' promise of the Holy Spirit to be fulfilled.

**We can ask God for wisdom (Acts 1:23-26):** When they were deciding who should replace Judas, the disciples prayed and asked God to show them the right person.

**God calls us to work in community with others (Acts 1:15-26):** The disciples prayed together, mourned together, and made decisions together.

#### UNIT 29, SESSION 3 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE

**The Holy Spirit came like tongues of fire (Acts 2:1-3):** The Holy Spirit came to believers in a powerful way.

**The disciples were able to speak other languages (Acts 2:4-8):** The Holy Spirit gave the disciples the power to speak in different languages.

**We need God's help to complete the mission He gave us (Acts 2:8-12):** Through the power of the Holy Spirit, the disciples were able to share the good news of Jesus with people in their own languages.

#### UNIT 29, SESSION 4 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE

**Paul was called to be a missionary (Galatians 5):** Jesus changed Paul's life. Paul went from persecuting Christians to sharing the good news of Jesus.

**We have freedom because Jesus set us free (Galatians 5:1-15):** The church in Galatia had false teachers telling them that their freedom came through following the law. But freedom comes through Jesus alone.

**The Holy Spirit transforms us (Galatians 5:16-26):** The Holy Spirit guides us to become more like Jesus and produce fruit that is pleasing to God.

#### UNIT 30, SESSION 1 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE

**Peter had compassion for unbelievers (Acts 2:14-15):** The people were making fun of the disciples. Instead of responding with anger, Peter explained what was actually happening and shared the gospel.

**Peter was not afraid to speak the truth (Acts 2:17-36):** Peter boldly shared Scripture from the Old Testament and how it pointed to Jesus as the Messiah.

**We can respond when we hear the truth (Acts 2:37-47):** After hearing Peter's message, about three thousand people chose to repent, be baptized, and join the community of believers.

#### UNIT 30, SESSION 2 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE

**Peter had wisdom to know what the man truly needed (Acts 3:1-8):** The man was begging for money, but Peter offered him healing.

**Peter healed in Jesus' name (Acts 3:6-8):** Peter commanded the man to get up and walk in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth.

**Our words have power so we should use them wisely (Acts 3:1-10):** Peter used his words to bring healing to the man, and the man used his words to praise God.

#### UNIT 30, SESSION 3 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE

**Peter was bold to continue preaching (Acts 4:1-4):** Peter was put in prison because he was teaching about Jesus, but that did not stop him from preaching truth.

**Peter was joyful even in suffering (Acts 4:8-12):** Peter was filled with the Holy Spirit, who gave him joy amidst trials.

**The message of the gospel will not be stopped (Acts 4:13-31):** The leaders realized they had no reason to hold Peter and John in prison. But Peter and John said they would continue talking about what Jesus had done regardless of whether they were in prison or free.

#### **UNIT 30, SESSION 4 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE**

**The early church practiced generosity (Acts 4:32-37):** The members of the early church shared what they had and made sure no one was lacking.

**Ananias and Sapphira were greedy (Acts 5:1-11):** Ananias and Sapphira chose to lie about what they had given to the God.

**The Holy Spirit helps us live generously (Acts 4:33-37):** The early church was not only extremely generous, but they were also joyful while doing so.

#### **UNIT 30, SESSION 5 - KIDS SERMON OUTLINE**

**Paul wrote about what it means to follow Jesus (Romans 10:9-13):** To be a Christian, you must confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead.

**Through the Holy Spirit we have power to impact the world (Romans 10:14-15):** If we have trusted in the Lord, then we are called to share the good news of Jesus with others.

**Each person responds to the good news of Jesus (Romans 10:16-21):** Some people will hear the good news, but not believe.
