## + **JESUS'S DISCIPLES OBEY CHRIST (ACTS 2:1).**

<sup>1</sup> When the day of Pentecost had arrived, they were all together in one place.

## **JESUS'S DISCIPLES ARE FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT (ACTS 2:2-5).**

<sup>2</sup> Suddenly a sound like that of a violent rushing wind came from heaven, and it filled the whole house where they were staying. <sup>3</sup> They saw tongues like flames of fire that separated and rested on each one of them. <sup>4</sup> Then they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them. <sup>5</sup> Now there were Jews staying in Jerusalem, devout people from every nation under heaven.

## **JESUS'S DISCIPLES REVEAL GOD'S WORKS (ACTS 2:6-13).**

<sup>6</sup> When this sound occurred, a crowd came together and was confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language. <sup>7</sup> They were astounded and amazed, saying, “Look, aren’t all these who are speaking Galileans? <sup>8</sup> How is it that each of us can hear them in our own native language? <sup>9</sup> Parthians, Medes, Elamites; those who live in Mesopotamia, in Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, <sup>10</sup> Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya near Cyrene; visitors from Rome (both Jews and converts), <sup>11</sup> Cretans and Arabs—we hear them declaring the magnificent acts of God in our own tongues.” <sup>12</sup> They were all astounded and perplexed, saying to one another, “What does this mean?” <sup>13</sup> But some sneered and said, “They’re drunk on new wine.”
