JESUS'S DISCIPLES OBEY CHRIST (ACTS 2:1).

¹ When the day of Pentecost had arrived, they were all together in one place.

JESUS'S DISCIPLES ARE FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT (ACTS 2:2-5).

² Suddenly a sound like that of a violent rushing wind came from heaven, and it filled the whole house where they were staying. ³ They saw tongues like flames of fire that separated and rested on each one of them. ⁴ Then they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them. ⁵ Now there were Jews staying in Jerusalem, devout people from every nation under heaven.

JESUS'S DISCIPLES REVEAL GOD'S WORKS (ACTS 2:6-13).

⁶ When this sound occurred, a crowd came together and was confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language. ⁷ They were astounded and amazed, saying, "Look, aren't all these who are speaking Galileans?" ⁸ How is it that each of us can hear them in our own native language? ⁹ Parthians, Medes, Elamites; those who live in Mesopotamia, in Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, ¹⁰ Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya near Cyrene; visitors from Rome (both Jews and converts), ¹¹ Cretans and Arabs—we hear them declaring the magnificent acts of God in our own tongues." ¹² They were all astounded and perplexed, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" ¹³ But some sneered and said, "They're drunk on new wine."
