## **GOD ACCEPTS ALL PEOPLE WHO BELIEVE THE GOSPEL** (ACTS 10:34-43).

<sup>34</sup> Peter began to speak: “Now I truly understand that God doesn’t show favoritism, <sup>35</sup> but in every nation the person who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him. <sup>36</sup> He sent the message to the Israelites, proclaiming the good news of peace through Jesus Christ — he is Lord of all. <sup>37</sup> You know the events that took place throughout all Judea, beginning from Galilee after the baptism that John preached: <sup>38</sup> how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, and how he went about doing good and healing all who were under the tyranny of the devil, because God was with him. <sup>39</sup> We ourselves are witnesses of everything he did in both the Judean country and in Jerusalem, and yet they killed him by hanging him on a tree. <sup>40</sup> God raised up this man on the third day and caused him to be seen, <sup>41</sup> not by all the people, but by us whom God appointed as witnesses, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. <sup>42</sup> He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one appointed by God to be the judge of the living and the dead. <sup>43</sup> All the prophets testify about him that through his name everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins.”

## **THE SPIRIT’S PRESENCE UNITES PEOPLE WHO BELIEVE THE GOSPEL** (ACTS 10:44-48).

<sup>44</sup> While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came down on all those who heard the message. <sup>45</sup> The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were amazed because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on the Gentiles. <sup>46</sup> For they heard them speaking in tongues and declaring the greatness of God. Then Peter responded, <sup>47</sup> “Can anyone withhold water and prevent these people from being baptized, who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?” <sup>48</sup> He commanded them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to stay for a few days.

## **THE CHURCH CELEBRATES WHEN PEOPLE BELIEVE THE GOSPEL** (ACTS 11:1-3,15-18).

<sup>1</sup> The apostles and the brothers and sisters who were throughout Judea heard that the Gentiles had also received the word of God. <sup>2</sup> When Peter went up to Jerusalem, the circumcision party criticized him, <sup>3</sup> saying, “You went to uncircumcised men and ate with them.” . . . <sup>15</sup> “As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit came down on them, just as on us at the beginning. <sup>16</sup> I remembered the word of the Lord, how he said, ‘John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.’ <sup>17</sup> If, then, God gave them the same gift that he also gave to us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, how could I possibly hinder God?” <sup>18</sup> When they heard this they became silent. And they glorified God, saying, “So then, God has given repentance resulting in life even to the Gentiles.”
