**Big Picture Question:** How can we glorify God? We can glorify God by loving Him and obeying Him..

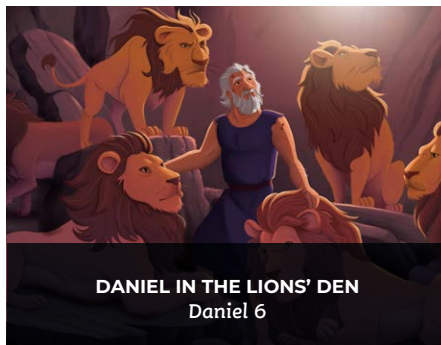

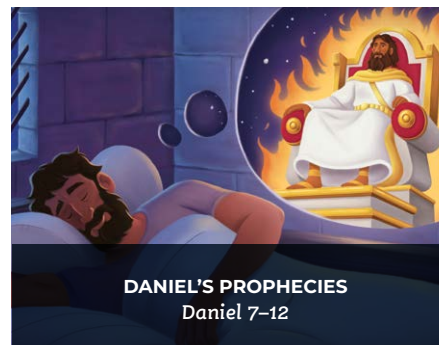

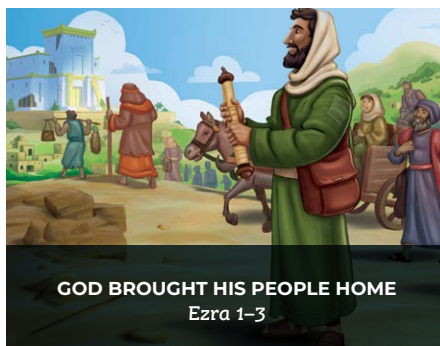


## UNIT 17 - HOPE AT HOME

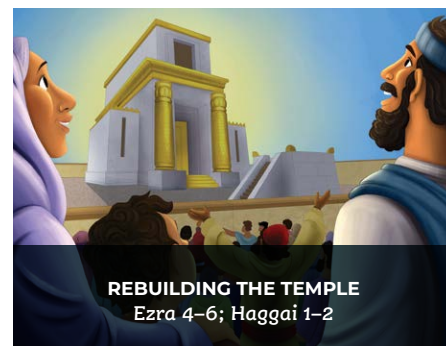

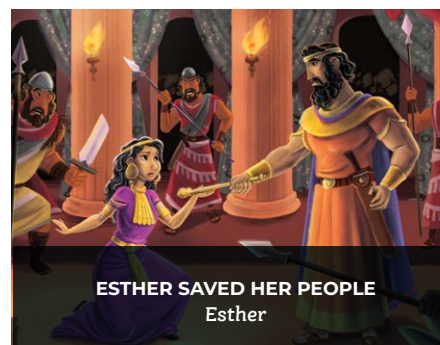

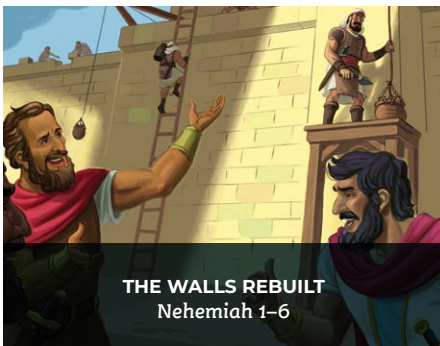


## UNIT 18 - HOPE TO COME

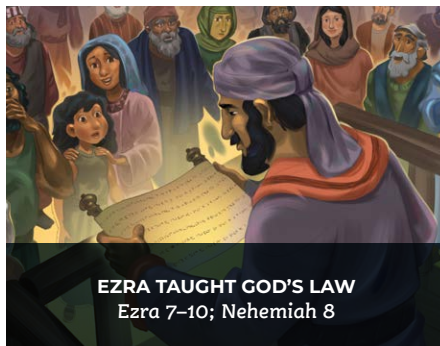
**Big Picture Question:** What is the Bible about? The Bible is the story of God's plan to save people through Jesus.
