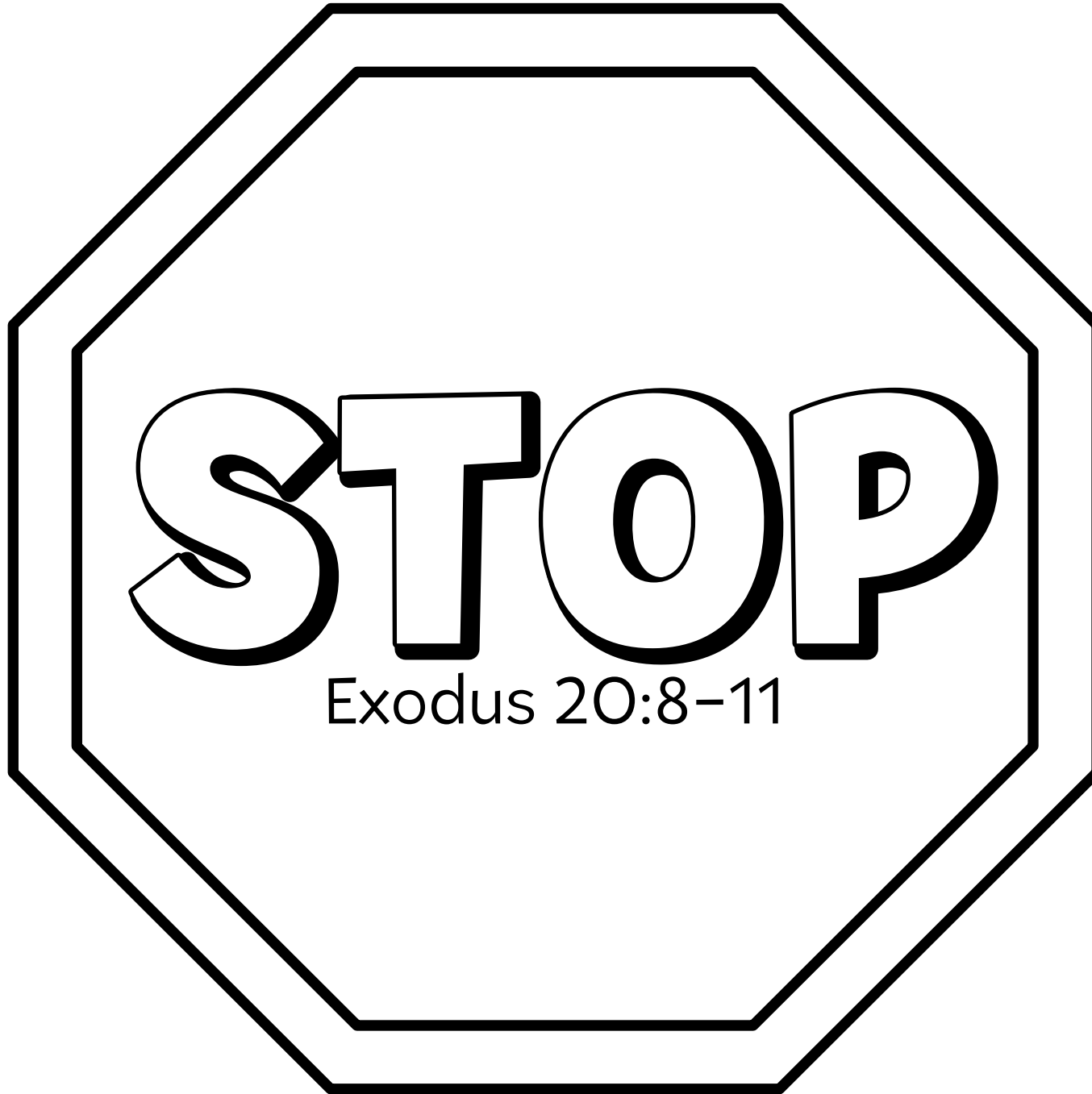

Pray, "Not my will, but Yours be done."

Prayer Path Instructions: Say each prompt slowly, pausing after each one for kids to draw or write.

Stop One-Praise God: At this stop, write or draw something that shows who God is.

Stop Two-Ask God: Now write or draw something you want to ask God for. This could be helpful for yourself or someone else.

Stop Three-Confess to God: Think about something you've done wrong. You can write or draw a symbol that helps you talk to God about it.

Stop Four-Listen to God: Write a quiet word or draw a picture that helps you think about listening to God—maybe something He wants you to do or remember.

Stop Five-Trust God: Think of something hard. Draw or write something that shows you are trusting God with it.
