

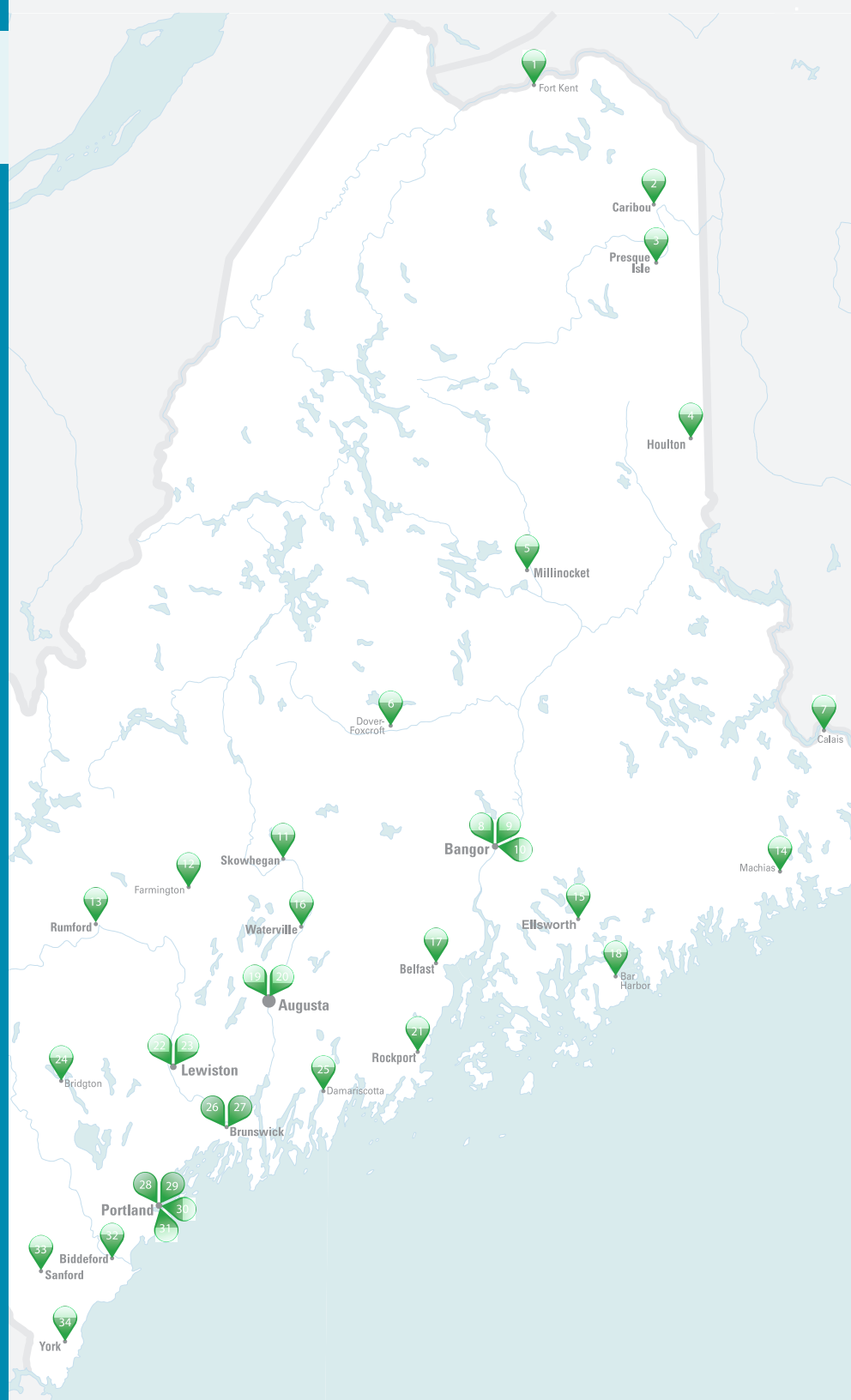


# Health Care Education Guided by the Needs of Maine Providers

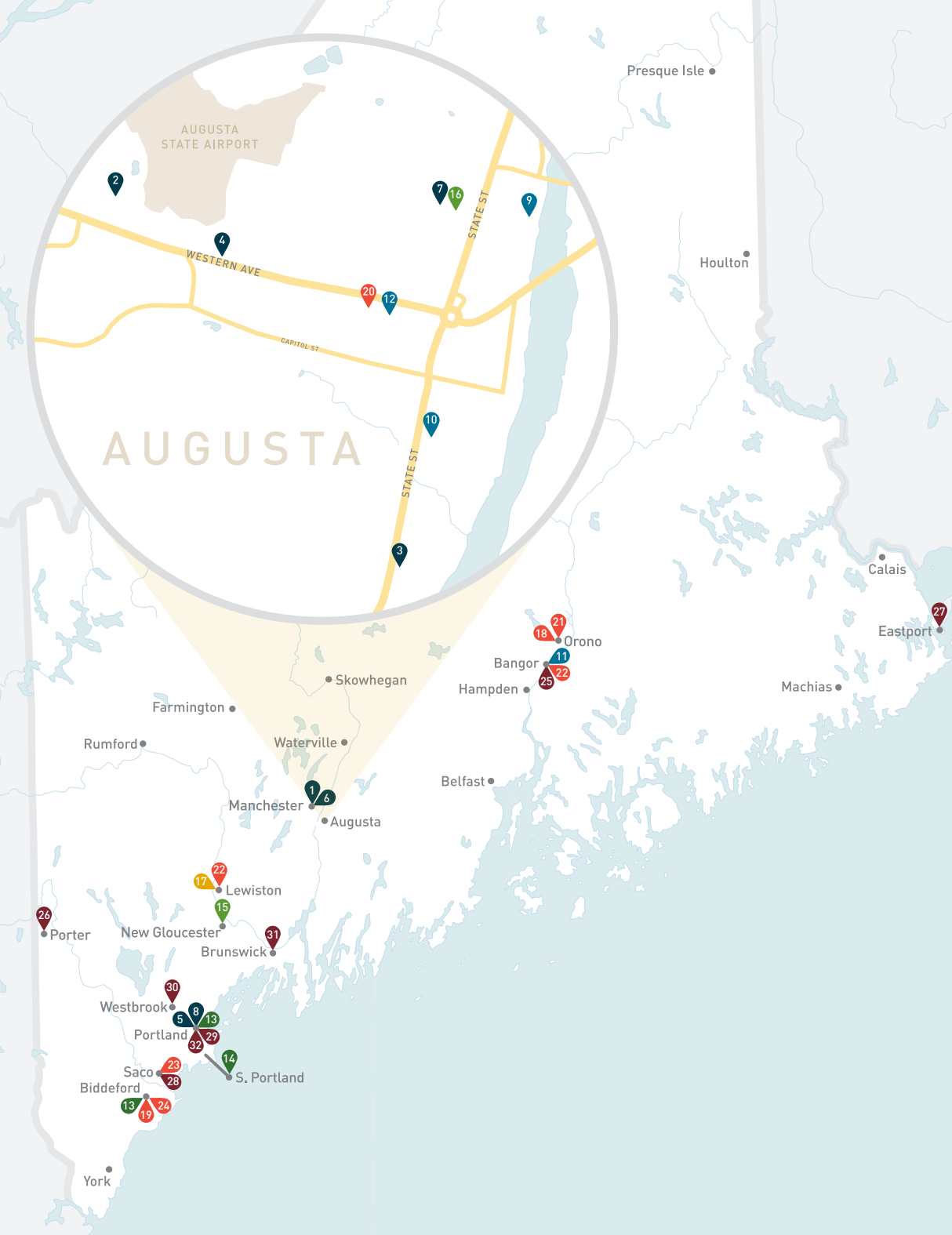
