Growth Groups @ The Journey

The Journey exists to give the people of New York City the best opportunity to become fully developing followers of Jesus.

CORE BELIEF: At The Journey, we believe our church must...

grow <u>LARGER</u> and <u>SMALLER</u> at the same time.

As a result, The Journey has 2 types of church meetings:

Large Group: Sunday Service

Small Group: Growth Group

How Does My Growth Group "WIN"?

My Growth Group "WINS" when together we apply God's biblical principles to our lives and pray for one another .

"You can develop a healthy, robust community that lives right with God and enjoy its results only if you do the **hard work** of getting along with each other, treating each other with dignity and honor." — James 3:18

The Journey Summer 2018 Growth Groups Growth Group Responsibilities

WHAT DOES MY GROWTH GROUP DO?

- Meets together once a week
- Serves together once a month
- Reaches out together once a semester
- Hangs together once a semester

WHAT DOES A GROWTH GROUP LEADER DO?

- Prays for group members daily
- Leads the group once a week
- Meets with Team Leader in a Growth Group Huddle at least once a semester
- Helps form new groups from their current group

WHAT DOES A GROWTH GROUP COORDINATOR DO?

- Prepares to become a Growth Group Leader by serving as an apprentice who supports and assists the Group Leader
- Facilitates group discussion multiple times during the semester
- Prays for the group

Each week the Coordinator sends 2 emails to the group:

- **1.** Prayer Requests Sent the day after group meets; email with prayer requests from previous day (recorded by coordinator)
- **2.** Group Reminder Sent two days before group meets; email with reminder about Growth Group that week (or any upcoming events GG Serving, GG Hangout, etc.)

Four F's of Leading a Growth Group

Who can I invite to be a part of my Growth Group?

- People in previous Growth Groups
- People I meet on Sunday
- People I meet when I'm serving
- People I meet at a Journey events

How do I tell people about my Growth Group?

- Serve at the Growth Group Table & hold up a sign on Sundays.
- Ask people who you meet on Sunday at the service to join your group.
- Email people who were in your previous Growth Group(s) and invite them to join.

What are other ways my group can fill up and be successful?

- People select a group because of its location, day, time and topic (in that order)
- Secure a Growth Group Coordinator for your Group

2. F OLLOW-UP

How do people sign up for my Growth group?

- **Sunday Signups:** From the services and the Growth Group Table are sent to you on Mondays.
- Online Signups: You receive an immediate email.

Three types of communication...

1. IMMEDIATE FOLLOW-UP

- As soon as someone signs up, email them all the details for your Growth Group.
 Sample Email Provided
- Within a few days of someone signing up, text call them to introduce yourself and try to meet them on Sunday.

2. PRE-GROUP COMMUNICATION

- Call/text your Group Members the week of your first meeting
- Two email reminders before the first meeting
 - o One 1 Week before
 - o One 1 Day before

3. ON-GOING COMMUNICATION

- Two weekly emails
 - Meeting reminder (2 days before meeting)
 - Prayer requests (day after meeting)

^{*}Challenge: DON'T LET ANYONE SLIP THROUGH THE CRACKS.

3. F OCUS

How can I prepare for my first Growth Group Meeting?

- Pray for your group and the individuals who sign up
 - When someone signs-up, immediately add them to your Growth Group list (keep an excel file with everyone's contact information).
 - Keep a 3" x 5" index card or a note on your phone with the names of everyone who signs up for your Growth Group.
 - Place this index card in a place that you will see everyday OR make that note the background of your phone and pray for your Growth Group members.
- Have a plan for your lesson and a place for your group to meet
 - Think through your itinerary (1st Group Meeting Itinerary)
 - Secure a meeting location NOW and let everyone know about it immediately. (including Journey staff)
- Lead your group through the Growth Group Covenant & Syllabus at your first meeting.
 - Growth Group Covenant
 - Share the Syllabus with your Group



4. F ACILITATE

How can I lead a successful Growth Group?

- Begin and end on time every time
- Encourage everyone to participate in discussion

- Don't let one person ruin it for everyone else
- Ask open-ended questions
- Provide the "2 C's"
 - o Care to Growth Group members
 - o **Communication** to Staff
- Serve at a Sunday service once a month this Summer
- Participate in one Growth Group SE project this Summer

*Challenge: BE PRESENT AT ALL YOUR GG'S SERVING OPPORTUNITIES

Four F's Checklist:

FILL-UP CHECKLIST:
Secure a Coordinator for your Growth Group.
Serve at the GG Table and ask people on Sunday to join my group.
Invite friends, neighbors, and co-workers to join my group.
FOLLOW-UP CHECKLIST:
Email every person who signs up for my group immediately with all of the important information: day/time/location, start date, syllabus, contact info, etc.
Call/text everyone who signs up for my group at least once before the group begins.
Send an email reminder two days before my group begins.
Continue following up with those who don't show up for Growth Group at least 2 weeks into the group (don't remove their name from the list until they request it).
FOCUS CHECKLIST:
Pray daily for those who have signed up for my group.
Secure a place for my group to meet.
$_$ Have the Syllabus and GG Covenant ready at the 1 $^{\rm st}$ group meeting.
FACILITATE CHECKLIST:
Send 2 weekly emails to my Growth Group: Group Reminder Email (two days before group meeting) and Prayer Requests (day after group meets).
Write down my group's Sunday serving and SE dates and communicate those dates to my group. Be faithful in leading my group to serve.
Continually identify potential leaders from my group and give them the opportunity to serve/lead within my group.

The Journey Summer 2018 Growth Groups

Itinerary for Your 1st Growth Group Meeting

- 1. First 15 Minutes: Allow people to arrive, talk, and snack 15 min.
- 2. **Introductions:** Have everyone introduce themselves and share what they do, where they are from, and why they decided to join the group 10 min.
- 3. Ice Breakers (See some favorite ideas below):
 - a. 2 Truths and a Lie: Have everyone tell 3 things about themselves (2 being true and 1 being false). Have everyone else try to guess which one is false.
 - b. A Penny for Your Thoughts: Bring a small bag of pennies from a variety of years to growth group. Everyone takes a penny as they pass the bag around, and they share a fond memory from the year that they chose. Have members put their penny back if they choose a year that they didn't live through. If you don't have many pennies, any other coins will do.
 - c. Little Known Facts: Ask each person in the group to think of two interesting, unusual, or humorous facts about themselves that no one else would know. Everyone takes a turn sharing their little known facts with the group. Be prepared for some wacky revelations!
 - d. *The Name Game:* Tell the story behind your name are you named after someone, does your name mean something special, etc.
- 4. **Introduce your Growth Group study:** Hand out **GG syllabus, bookmarks** and any other important information. Answer any questions 5-10 minutes.
- 5. **Growth Group Covenant**: Read through the Growth Group Covenant carefully with the group. Explain the points as you read each one. Answer any questions. If anyone tries to be difficult or disagreeable, offer to talk with them individually at the end of the meeting 10-15 min.
- 6. **Explain and ask for volunteers for the different roles within the group:** Playgroup Coordinator, Food Coordinator, etc. 5 minutes.
- 7. Share prayer requests and pray together 10 minutes.
- 8. Talk and eat 15 minutes.
