Come along on a journey with Mark to create a compelling, dramatic image using grey skies and bright tropical sun-drenched colours - creating a glorious contrasting wave in the foreground. Investigate brush technique and theory to understand the science behind why a wave breaks, and the shapes and behaviour of water and waves, including whitewash.

As always with a Mark Waller workshop, the focus is on expanding your knowledge and skills to improve all your paintings going forward, rather than necessarily coming away with a finished, polished piece.

Learn the signature Mark Waller moves for refraction, reflection and gradation.

## Materials needed:

### Paint:

Atelier Interactive Artists Acrylics

- » Titanium White
- » Pthalo Blue
- » French Ultramarine Blue
- » Cadmium Yellow Light
- » Cadmium Yellow Medium
- » Burnt Umber
- » Dioxazine Purple

Atelier Free Flow Artists Acrylics

- » Titanium White (great for details)

### Canvas:

- » 3 x pre-primed canvases -
- » 2 @ (approx) 400mm x 500mm

- » 1 @ (approx) 600mm x 750mm

### Brushes:

- » 4-5 flat brushes in varying sizes (eg 2,6,8,12), 1 large house painting brush approx 5-10cm accross for large gradations and softening.

### Easel:

- » your own robust freestanding or table top easel

### Extras (optional):

- » water spray bottle
- » Atelier Universal Medium
