This is a workshop with a difference! You will come along with your background already blocked in:) Don't worry, we'll have a detailed video tutorial for you to complete your blocking in well before the workshop. This workshop assumes a rudimentary level of skill with acrylics, and you must complete the prescribed blocking in processes before the workshop. Often we get very caught up with the blocking in process at our workshops - this time we want to really focus on colour relationships and brush techniques, and have you take away a finished painting you can be proud of!

This is an exercise in understanding the nuance of hue and tone in relation to the light. We'll be exploring added elements including clouds, waves, reflections, and a headland, being mindful of the warm to cool principles, as well as the effect that the light has on all the objects. We'll be paying particular attention to the difference in the way light affects all objects, relative to their distance from the light source. This workshop will focus in on brush technique, your observation skills, and will require a gentle hand. Get your subtle on! We'll be using a fairly limited palette to keep our colours under control.

We'll provide a detailed video tutorial on blocking in your background. The sky and water areas, from the intense light through to the darker areas. If you need additional support for this part, we are more than happy to help walk you through.

This workshop begins the moment you enrol.
