Build on your foundational knowledge of the fundamentals of water (see our webpage here, and our Youtube playlist here.) in this one day acrylic painting workshop with Mark in gorgeous Lennox Head.

We'll focus on creating an image of deeper water splashing around rocks, and will use that image to understand why and how water does what it does, and of course, how to paint it.

You'll discover brush technique to create the illusion of water movement and transparency, and at the same time learn how to mix the colours you need to create the illusion of light and dynamic movement in your water.

Our workshop environment is fun and stress-free, and open to all skill levels.

Titanium White  
Pthalo Blue  
French Ultramarine Blue  
Cadmium Yellow Light  
Cadmium Yellow Medium  
Dioxazine Purple  
Burnt Umber  
Forest Green  
Permanent Alizarine

**Atelier Free Flow Artists Acrylics**  
Titanium White

Water Spray Bottle (*optional*)

**Canvas:** 3 x Canvas boards 10" x 12" (roughly 300mm x 255mm) - two will be to practice elements.

Two of these need to be pre-painted with flat, neat Pthalo Blue (you can add a teensy bit of white to the Pthalo Blue if you want).

**Brushes:** 3 x flat synthetic brushes in varying sizes (eg 6,8,12), and a small fan brush (size 4).

**We will provide a stand up easel however feel free to bring a tabletop easel if you would prefer.**
