Unlike other workshops with Mark, this is a "follow-along", "finished painting" style workshop! Create a gorgeous, panoramic, sun-drenched, tropical surf bay over two days, broken down into manageable chunks. Along the way, you'll learn about:

- » Perspective and water - yes, it has some!
- » Wet sand and reflections.
- » Having the confidence to create a simple, but compelling image.
- » Less is more - make use of "space" in the image.
- » Gradations - keep discovering the importance of this fundamental skill!
- » Handling water in the distance and the foreground.
- » Painting clouds, waves and island foliage.

Use your beachscapes recipe book to help create this image. (If you don't have one we'll have some available).

## Materials needed:

**Paint:** Atelier Interactive Artists  
Titanium White  
Pthalo Blue  
French Ultramarine Blue  
Cadmium Yellow Light  
Cadmium Yellow Medium  
Dioxazine Purple  
Burnt Umber  
Forest Green  
Pthalo Green  
Water spray bottle

**Canvas:** 4 x pre-primed canvas boards approx 10" x 12",  
1 x pre-primed stretched canvas approx 80cm x 40cm.

**Brushes:** 5 flat brushes in varying sizes (eg 2,6,8,10,12), + one large flat brush, approx 5cm across

**Easel:** your own robust freestanding or table top easel (we do have easels available, let us know if you need one - no cost for these)
